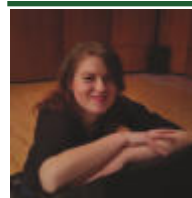

HOLY COMMUNION DURING THE FLU SEASON

Due to the severity of the flu season, we have been directed that the Precious Blood not be distributed in any form at Mass beginning this weekend, and continuing throughout the winter months or until the flu season ends.

This same precaution is being implemented by other parishes and dioceses, here in the U.S. and also in the dioceses of the United Kingdom.

During this time, we are also asked to avoid bodily contact during the Sign of Peace. A simple bow of the head will be sufficient.
