Important Faith Formation Reminders

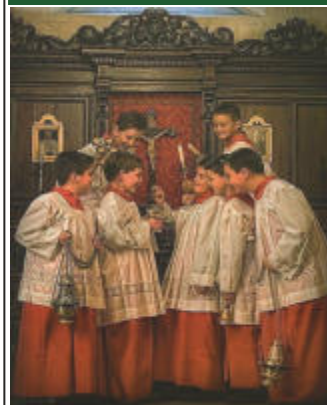
A Few Winter Reminders for our Faith Formation Families:

Heads up: Over the next two weeks we will hear an extended passage from Matthew's Gospel, in which Jesus reinterprets the law for his disciples.

He challenges his disciples to take it one step further, to do more than just follow the letter of the law.

On this Presidents Day weekend, when we honor those people whom we have trusted to guide our country, let us consider how we can trust Jesus to guide us in our daily lives.

THE WORD SPEAKS

In the first reading, Sirach teaches us that we have the ability to choose between right and wrong. Choosing to trust in God and to keep the commandments is the way to salvation.

Jesus extends the commandments when speaking to his disciples, telling them that they must do more.

May the Holy Spirit, invoked by St. Paul in the second reading, reveal God's wisdom, and guide us in our behavior.

LENTEN JOURNEY TO EASTER SUNDAY

Fr. Tony is inviting you to join him and others starting Tuesday March 17th, 2020 at 6:00pm in the Church Hall. Doors open at 5:00pm for soup and sandwich, and brief evening prayer, followed by introduction to the "33 Days to Greater Glory" (by Fr. Michal Gaitley, MIC) which will end on Divine Mercy Sunday at 10am Mass. Refreshments and fellowship will follow the Mass. We will make a public Consecration to God the Father on Divine Mercy Sunday.

ANNUAL NOVENA TO THE DIVINE MERCY

Our annual novena to the Divine Mercy begins on Good Friday, and continues daily through Easter Week, ending with the eve of the Feast of the Divine Mercy.

Lenten Regulations for Catholics:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics.

In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Those who are sincerely unable — due to health or work reasons—to fulfill these regulations, should discuss with their pastors or confessors other suitable penitential practices, rather than to simply exempt themselves from observance.
