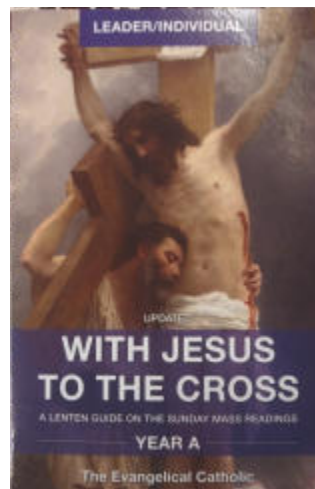

Dear Friends ~

During this holy season, we examine and reflect upon our lives, and we call on God for His aid.

There are times in our lives — and this may be one of them — when we feel alone and/or abandoned. We ask, as the chosen people did when thirsting in the desert, "Is the Lord in our midst or not?"

As we grow weary crossing the deserts in our life, let us remember Jesus' words, "I am with you always."

THE WORD SPEAKS

Water takes center stage in Scripture today.

The Chosen People grow thirsty in the desert and the Lord provides water from the rock in Horeb.

The Psalmist recalls this event to urge us not to harden our hearts as they did.

Paul suggests the image of water in stating that the love of God has been poured into our hearts.

Then, in the Gospel, a thirsty Samaritan Woman realizes that in Jesus she has received living water.

Let us quench our thirst with God's word.

Lenten Regulations for Catholics:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics.

In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Those who are sincerely unable — due to health or work reasons—to fulfill these regulations, should discuss with their pastors or confessors other suitable penitential practices, rather than to simply exempt themselves from observance.
