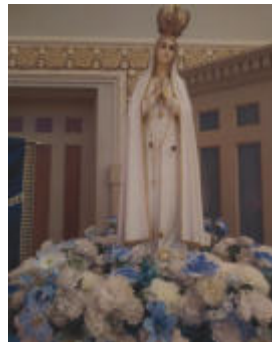

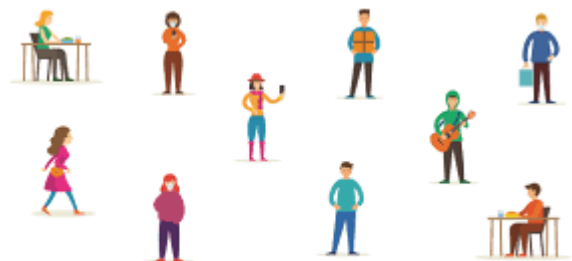

Today we hear Jesus giving life itself to someone who has died. The giver of water and light is also the giver of life itself.

Let us thank God for the gift of our Savior, as we prepare for the final two weeks of Lent.

Ezekiel shares a radical vision of Israel's future: God will burst open graves, reanimate the dead, and restore them to their land.

Jesus puts such a plan into action, opening the tomb of Lazarus, bringing him back to life, and restoring him to his family.

Paul assures us that with the Spirit within us, our mortal bodies will have life as well.

Listening to scripture, let us reflect on how God's redeeming grace raises us up from our sin and despair.

How can I free myself from the “burial bonds” in my life? How can I help others to be freed from theirs?

PRIVATE PRAYER IN CHURCH

The Church doors, from the Parking Lot Only, will be open from 9:00am to 11:00am, Tuesday through Friday for Private Prayer—Except as noted for Holy Week & Easter—See Page 3; in Fr. Tony's Lenten Message.

Parishioners may enter from the Parking Lot / Parish Hall Entrance. Please keep ample space between yourselves while in the building. No one will be permitted to remain in the building after 11:30am for any reason.

Lenten Regulations for Catholics:

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Those who are unable — due to health or work reasons—should offer up some other suitable sacrifice.

Blessed Palms will be available outside the back door (parking lot entrance) on Sunday, April 5th, from 11am—2pm, and inside the back door on Tuesday & Wednesday of Holy Week, from 9am to 11am.
