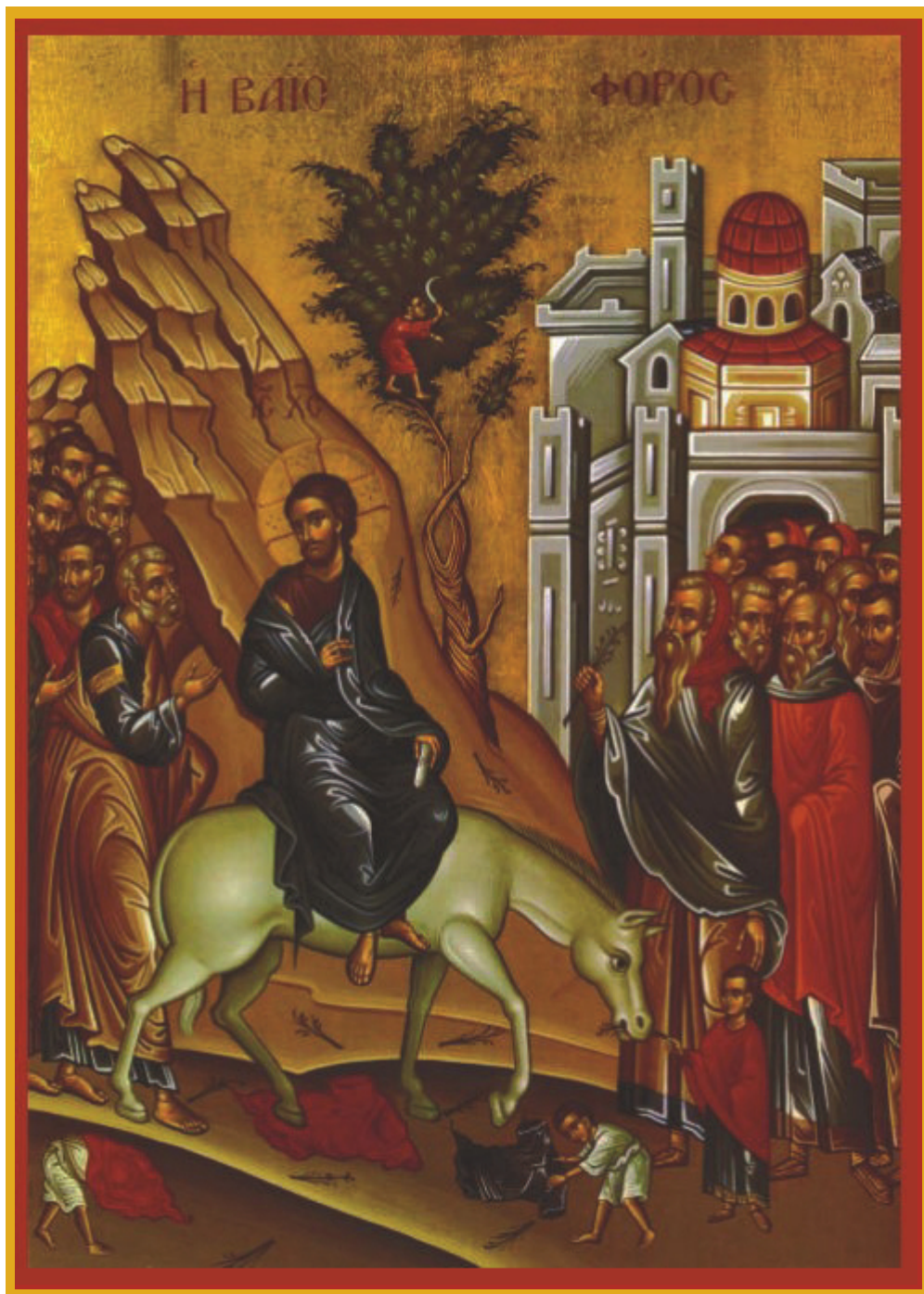

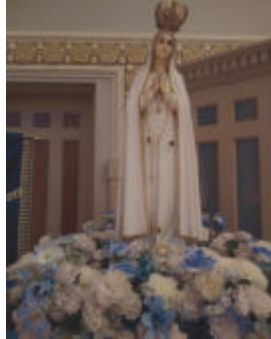

I will hear private confessions — behind the screen in the confessional—from 9am to 11am on each of those three days. The church building will also be open on Good Friday, from 2pm-4pm, and I will again hear confessions —behind the screen in the confessional — from 2pm to 3pm.
