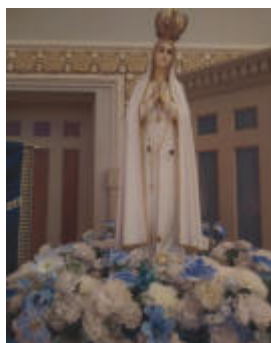

Once again, here is the text of my message I delivered on Sunday, May 17th, at our 10am Live-Stream Mass:

I'm sorry to have to speak to you through live-streaming technology, rather than in person, but given the prevailing pandemic situation, this is the mode we have available, and I have information to share with you.

I have been your pastor for the past 11 years. Much has taken place since my first years with you. These years have been good, even though we have all lived through some sadness also as we have bid final farewells to beloved deacons, priests, parish members, and family members. We trust these faithful departed to the care and mercy of God, and pray that they are at peace in His kingdom.

Transitions, and saying good-bye are always bitter-sweet, but as the people of God's family, we know that change is a given – and is part of God's plan for the good of everyone involved.

After discussions with our bishop and with my Franciscan provincial superior, I have decided that it is time for me to retire from my position as your pastor. Religious Priests, including Franciscans, never really retire – as we always remain active as celebrants, chaplains, or in other such ministries without the administrative demands of leading a parish.

Like any change, it will be strange and perhaps difficult at first, so we all need to pray to be open to the direction of Holy Spirit as He leads us in God's will.

While I feel some sadness as I prepare to leave “SSPP”, I am also very happy for all of you – as you will be welcoming Father Jose Lopez as your new pastoral leader in August of this year.

I have known Fr. Jose since 2009. He is a happy, young priest of our diocese. He is a faithful and dedicated Catholic Priest, loves our Blessed Mother, and is devoted to the Holy Eucharist and Perpetual Adoration. I know that he will be a good pastor for our parish!

So, I ask you to give him a warm welcome to our community of faith, and work with him as he adjusts to his new ministry here.

I will still be here, as your pastor, for the next two and half months! I will find some creative ways of saying my good-byes to all of you, since we cannot yet be together in a public setting.

I plan to leave in early August, and Fr. Jose will arrive shortly thereafter.

For now, I want to share with you the Blessing of St. Francis of Assisi:

May the Lord bless you and keep you.
May He shower you with his Light.
May He give you all His lasting Peace.

A Una vez más, aquí está el texto de mi mensaje que entregué el domingo 17 de mayo en nuestra misa de transmisión en vivo a las 10 a.m.

Querida familia de San Pedro y San Pablo, ¡Espero que todos tengan buena salud y han estado bien. Lamento tener que compartir con ustedes a través de la tecnología de transmisión en vivo, en lugar de en persona pero dada la situación de pandemia internacional, este es el modo disponible, y tengo algo para compartir con ustedes. He servido como su parroco durante los últimos 11 años. Mucho ha sucedido desde mis primeros años con ustedes. Estos años han sido buenos, a pesar de que todos hemos vivido una cierta tristeza también, ya que nos hemos despedido definitivamente de los queridos diáconos, sacerdotes, miembros de la parroquia y familiares. Los encomendamos a los fieles difuntos a la misericordia de Dios y oramos para que estén en paz en la casa del Señor. Los cambios y las despedidas son agri dulces, pero siendo personas de la familia de Dios, sabemos que el cambio es un hecho y es parte del plan de Dios para el bien de todo el mundo.

Después de discernir con nuestro obispo y con mi superior provincial franciscano, he decidido que es tiempo para jubilarme de mi ministerio como su parroco. Los sacerdotes religiosos, incluidos los franciscanos, nunca se jubilan realmente, ya que siempre nos mantenemos activos como celebrantes, capellanes o en otros ministerios sin las exigencias administrativas de dirigir una parroquia.

Cualquier cambio nos presenta algo extraño y quizás difícil al principio, por lo que todos debemos orar para estar abiertos al movimiento del Espíritu Santo mientras Él nos guía en la voluntad de Dios.

Siento tristeza mientras me preparo para retirarme de la parroquia, pero también estoy muy feliz por todos ustedes, ya van a darle la bienvenida al Padre José López como su nuevo párroco en Agosto.

He conocido a Padre José desde 2009. Es un sacerdote de nuestra diócesis muy feliz y muy joven. Es un sacerdote católico fiel y dedicado, con una gran devoción a nuestra Santísima Madre y una profunda devoción a la Sagrada Eucaristía y la Adoración Perpetua. ¡Sé que será un buen parroco para nuestra parroquia!

Entonces, les pido que le den una cálida bienvenida a nuestra comunidad de fe y que trabaje con él mientras se adapta a su nuevo ministerio aquí en la parroquia.

¡Sigo aquí como su parroco, durante los próximos dos meses y medio! Encontraré algunas formas creativas para despedirme de todos ustedes, ya que todavía no podemos estar juntos en grupos grandes.

Planeo irme a principios de agosto, y el p. José llegará poco después. Por ahora, quiero compartir con ustedes la Bendición de San Francisco de Asís:
