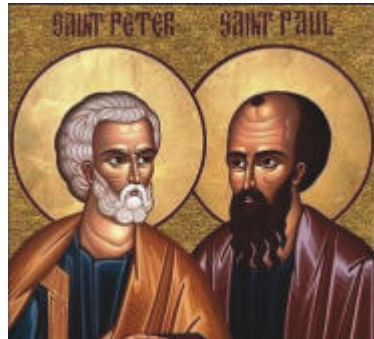

Fr. José will take up residence in the rectory on Wednesday, August 5th.

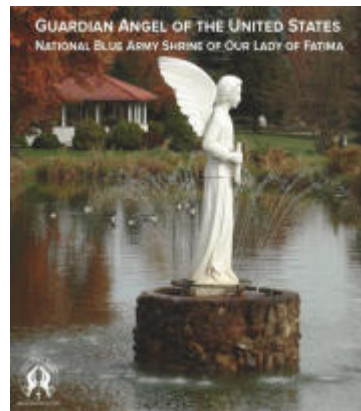
