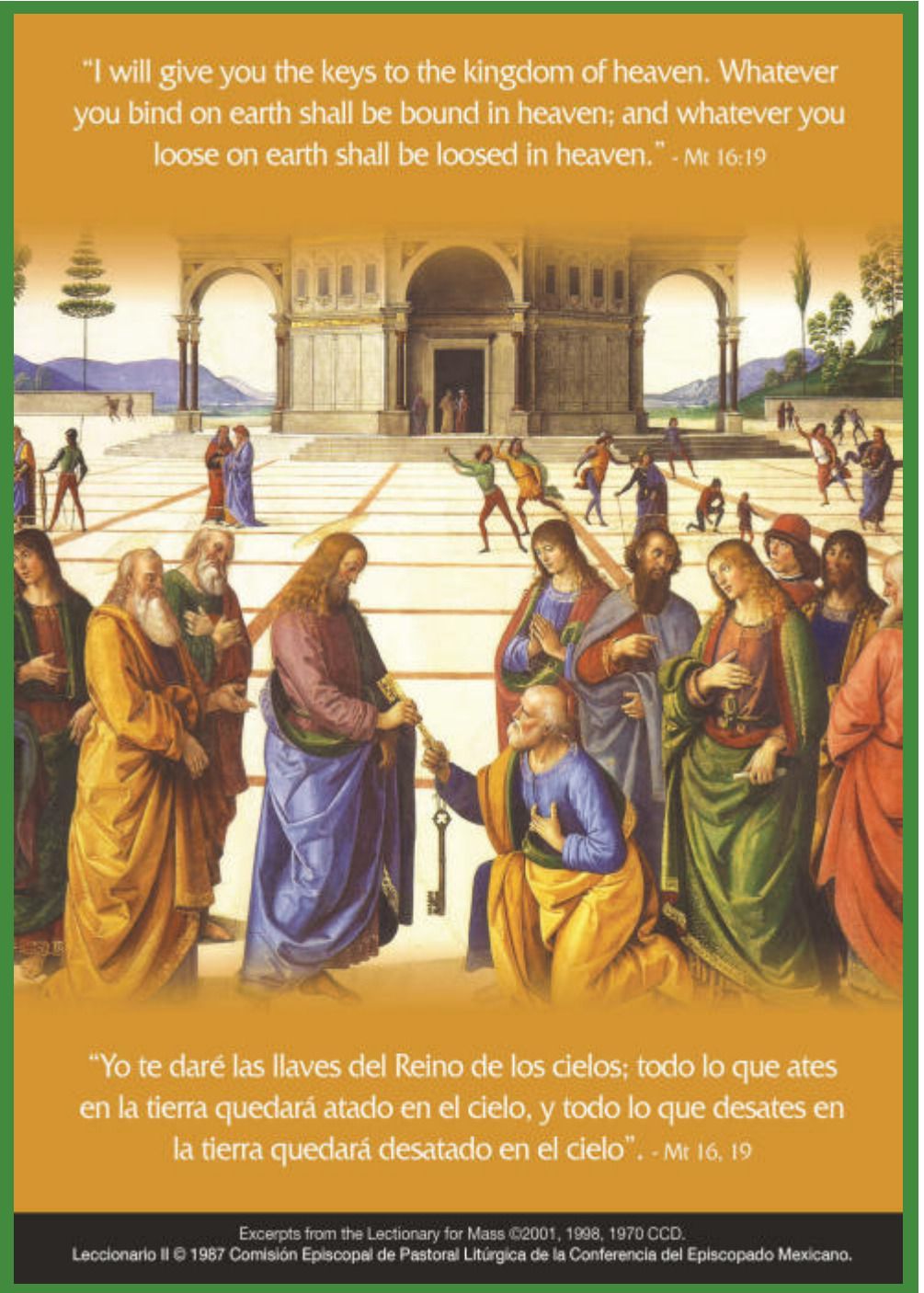

VERITAS FAITH FORMATION Classes for 1st Communion & Confirmation

Pre-Registration will begin on Monday, August 24th, for Sacramental Preparation Classes, for 1st Communion (students in 2nd grade and up) and Confirmation (students who are age 16 and up).

A copy of each student’s Baptismal Certificate will be required at the first class session in October.

These will be in-person classes, with all necessary COVID-19 protocols. The fee for 1st Communion Classes is \$25.00, and the fee for Confirmation Classes is \$40.00. Fees payable at 1st class session. Help is available for those in financial need.

Classes will begin in October, and will be held in church and/or in the parish hall. Parents will be welcome to attend with their children. Days, Dates, & Times to be announced

A modified homeschool program, utilizing various technologies & platforms is being planned for “non-sacramental” students in grades 1-12; details soon.

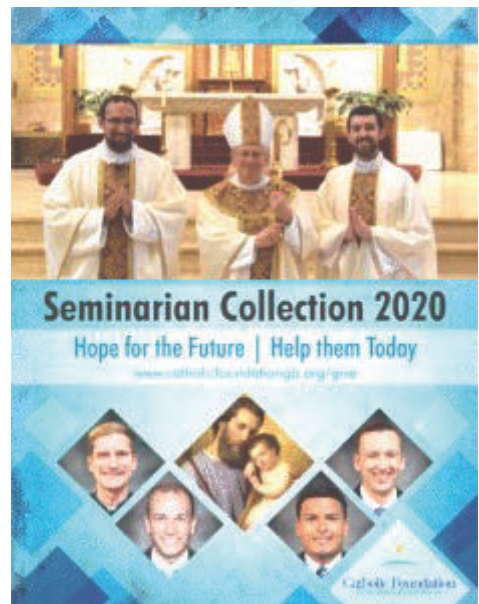

Dear Parish Family,

I pray and hope you and your families are doing well. This past week I was at Shepherd School, learning how to be a good parish priest. I thank you for your prayers and patience as I learn how to be a good spiritual father and parish administrator.

In this Sunday's Gospel, we have a powerful and crucial revelation that Jesus gives to His apostles. Peter becomes the Prince of the Apostles and the rock on which our Lord would build His church.

Notice how Jesus does a shift from asking his apostles what *OTHERS* think of him, to asking *THEM* what *THEY* think of Him. *Our Lord engaged them in this personal dialogue, in this sincere conversation with Him, and from this engagement our Lord gave Peter a mission.*

There is a pattern in this encounter that we must ponder in order for us to grow spiritually. Jesus wants to engage us in an honest dialogue, a real, sincere conversation from heart-to-heart with us. Then, from our engagement with our Lord in prayer, He gives us a mission to accomplish for the greater glory of God.

There are so many souls in our world that have wandered away from Jesus Christ because no one has reached out to them. Our Lord wants to use you and your family to bring back those who have walked away from Him. Jesus has a mission for you, and in order to know what that mission is, we must encounter our Lord in prayer.

Jesus lovingly gazed at Peter and pierced his heart. Peter then responded, moved by the Holy Spirit. Jesus longs to pierce our hearts by His powerful gaze and then send us on mission with our hearts on fire with His mercy.

"Who do YOU say that I am?" Jesus is waiting for your response. Will you be willing to engage His piercing gaze?
