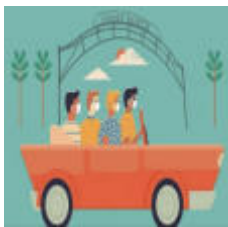

Dear Ss. Peter & Paul Parish Family,

Today Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, we Franciscans honor the Mother of God under the title of Our Lady of the Angels of the Portiuncula (*little portion*).

The Church celebrates this day every year as a Day of Pardon and forgiveness in the Spirit of St. Francis and St. Clare of Assisi as they both received the call to be reconcilers in their active and contemplative vocations.

This weekend I say my good-byes to all of you who have made my life and ministry better as we shared all of our ups and downs in life. We have shared illness and recovery, differences, and hurt feelings (unintentionally towards one another).

So, On this day of Pardon, Let me ask your forgiveness for the times I may have disappointed you, or hurt your feelings. As I have said many times over the past 11 years, I am a wounded minister seeking healing like all of us. So, on this day of Pardon and reconciliation we ask the Lord to heal the hurts of the past, to help us "let go" and move into the present and future - renewed by what we have shared.

The future is in God's hands. Let us pray for each other and support the mission of the Church on the corner of University and Baird, as our diocese calls us to be missionary disciples of Christ. Amen.

Peace & Love to all of you and to the many extended friends and family of SSPP-GB. I will carry many good memories of my time with you here at our beautiful parish.

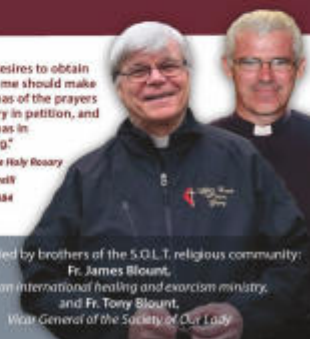

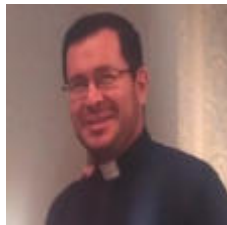
