

Dear Parish Family,

Jesus continues to find different ways to invite us into this great feast of being in communion with Him.

The Father, who is the King in this parable, has prepared a great feast for His Son and unfortunately, even in these days after Jesus' death, resurrection, ascension, and outpouring of His Holy Spirit at Pentecost, some continue to ignore this humble and powerful invitation from the King. As a spiritual father, I'm not so much concerned with numbers right now; I want to spend my time, energy, and efforts with those of you who are coming to Jesus. I have no doubt that if we come to Jesus in humble prayer asking, begging our Lord to transform us as individuals, then our whole parish will transform into a great community of disciples of Jesus Christ - on fire with His Holy Spirit and eager to lead others to God.

I take very seriously the salvation of all souls in our parish boundaries. I need your help in this massive task, but most importantly we need the power and fire of the Holy Spirit to use us as His instruments.

I pray and hope that together with the help of God, we may lead every individual to the oceans of mercy in the Heart of Jesus. The Father, the King has prepared this great feast for His Son Jesus Christ, and He is inviting us to come and feast with him! You and I are invited. May we give ourselves fully to our Lord. whose feasting never ceases -- it is ongoing and lifegiving. I pray and hope that we are able to live always in union with our Lord in our hearts.

The King is inviting -- are you willing to respond with a whole-hearted YES? You'll never regret it. Let us pray for one another, that we may come to know Jesus, love Him with our whole heart, and serve Him through those whose paths we cross. Praised be Jesus Christ our King!
