Dear Parish Family,

Jesus said to His disciples, “You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind...” (Mt 22:34-40).

Jesus presents this to be the greatest of all commandments. Why would Jesus command us to love the Lord our God with all our being?

We’ve discussed how every commandment leads us to the source of life. The commandments exist only for the sake of leading us to the one who created us and who loves us infinitely.

These words from Jesus in today’s gospel are much more than just a simple invitation to love His Father. He commands us to do so only if we desire to attain true and lasting happiness.

Our heavenly Father is always attentive to our needs. “If he cries out to me, I will hear him; for I am compassionate” (Ex. 22:26).

In Jesus’ words we hear his reminder to turn to the compassionate Father who is always willing to hear us. The love of God is the greatest of all the commandments, because it is in turning to God that our suffering encounters the healing compassion of the Father. In turning to God, our deepest longing encounters the consoling, merciful gaze of the Father.

Our cry to God must be sincere and full of trust in the compassionate Father.

Today’s Psalm gives us a great model to follow in our prayer life, “O Lord, my rock, my fortress, my deliverer... my rock of refuge, my shield...my stronghold...” (Ps 18).

This is the cry of someone who trusts in God and knows that in Him the source of love is found. Jesus’ will is that we may come to taste the life giving waters of the Father’s heart.

He desires that we may turn to God wholeheartedly, so that we may encounter the merciful and compassionate Father.

Jesus’ commandment can’t be forced upon us. We either desire to love God our Lord with all our being or not. Some may love him just a bit, and yet others chose to turn away from His merciful love. Either way, the Father’s gaze is always waiting for the moment that we decide to love Him.

What is it that you love with your whole being? Is it God? Yourself? Or something else?

Your heart longs for authentic love and happiness--only in God do we encounter what our souls desperately seek.

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

Jesús dijo a sus discípulos:

“Amarás al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón, con toda tu alma y con toda tu mente...” (Mt 22, 34-40).

Jesús presenta esto como el más grande de todos los mandamientos.

¿Por qué Jesús nos mandaría a amar al Señor nuestro Dios con todo nuestro ser? Hemos hablado de cómo cada mandamiento nos lleva a la fuente de la vida. Los mandamientos existen solo para llevarnos al que nos creó y nos ama infinitamente. Estas palabras de Jesús son mucho más que una simple invitación a amar a Su Padre, nos manda que lo hagamos como si realmente deseamos alcanzar la felicidad verdadera y duradera.

Nuestro Padre celestial siempre está atento a nuestras necesidades. “Cuando Él clame a mí, yo lo escucharé, porque soy misericordioso” (Éxodo 22:26). En las palabras de Jesús, escuchamos su recordatorio de que regresemos hacia el Padre misericordioso que siempre está dispuesto a escucharnos.

El amar a Dios es el más grande de todos los mandamientos, porque al voltear a Dios en nuestro sufrimiento encontramos la compasión sanadora del Padre. Al volvernos a Dios, nuestro más profundo anhelo se encuentra con la mirada consoladora y misericordiosa del Padre.

Nuestro clamor a Dios debe ser sincero y lleno de confianza en el Padre compasivo. El Salmo de hoy es un gran modelo a seguir en nuestra oración. “Tu eres mi fuerza, el Dios que protege y me libera...mi refugio, mi salvación, mi escudo, mi castillo... (Sal 18). Este es el clamor de quien confía en Dios y sabe que en Él se encuentra la fuente del amor. La voluntad de Jesús es que lleguemos a saborear los torrentes de agua viva del corazón del Padre; Él desea que nos volteemos a Dios de todo corazón para que podamos encontrarnos con el Padre misericordioso y compasivo.

El mandamiento de Jesús no se nos puede imponer. O deseamos amar a Dios nuestro Señor con todo nuestro ser o no. Algunos pueden amarlo un poco y otros optan por alejarse de Su amor misericordioso. De cualquier manera, la mirada del Padre siempre está esperando el momento en que decidimos amarlo. ¿Qué es lo que amas con todo tu ser? ¿Dios? ¿Usted mismo? ¿O algo más?

Tu corazón anhela el amor auténtico y la felicidad duradera, solo en Dios encuentras lo que nuestras almas buscan desesperadamente.
