Dear Parish Family,

I pray and hope that you and your families are doing well and keeping healthy throughout this difficult time.

You may already be aware, but we had to temporarily close the parish office for in-person services.

A member of our team has tested positive for Covid-19, and some other team members were exposed as well. For the sake of safety and prudence, our office building will reopen on Thursday, Nov 19th for in-person services.

We are still working remotely from home and are available via phone during office hours. Please keep our team members and all affected by the pandemic in your prayers. In the last few days and weeks we have become aware of a higher number of parishioners and friends of the parish who have been struggling with the virus.

Fortunately, some are able to fight it off easily, and they are able to recuperate quickly. Others continue to struggle with multiple visits to the hospitals due to the illness. So we pray for their recovery and for the end of this terrible illness.

In today's gospel we hear the voice of Jesus inviting us to be faithful in small matters so that we can be trusted with bigger responsibilities (Mt. 25:14-30).

As I pray with these words of Jesus, I feel convicted to be more attentive and faithful to what I am asked to do by my superiors. Throughout this pandemic, the diocese has asked us to social distance, wear masks, take care of proper precautions for the sake of the health and safety of all.

I believe that we have been careful as a parish to protect and care for our people. However, I do feel convicted in the sense that I have not mentioned the protocols perhaps as often as I should.

I strongly believe that we are adults and have the gift of common sense to care for ourselves and for others. We all know what the requirements are and I hope that we follow our conscience in regards to what is asked of us.

I feel convicted to simply ask you to please be careful and act prudently, always with the good of

others in your heart. I love our church and want to see it open for us to gather and worship our Lord, Jesus Christ.

I haven't heard of anyone getting the virus at Church and I thank the Lord for this, but I do hear the stories of our parishioners who have struggled with it. Let us work together for both the spiritual and physical health and safety of our people, the children of God.

May we long to hear the words of Jesus speaking to us, "well done, my good and faithful servant..."
