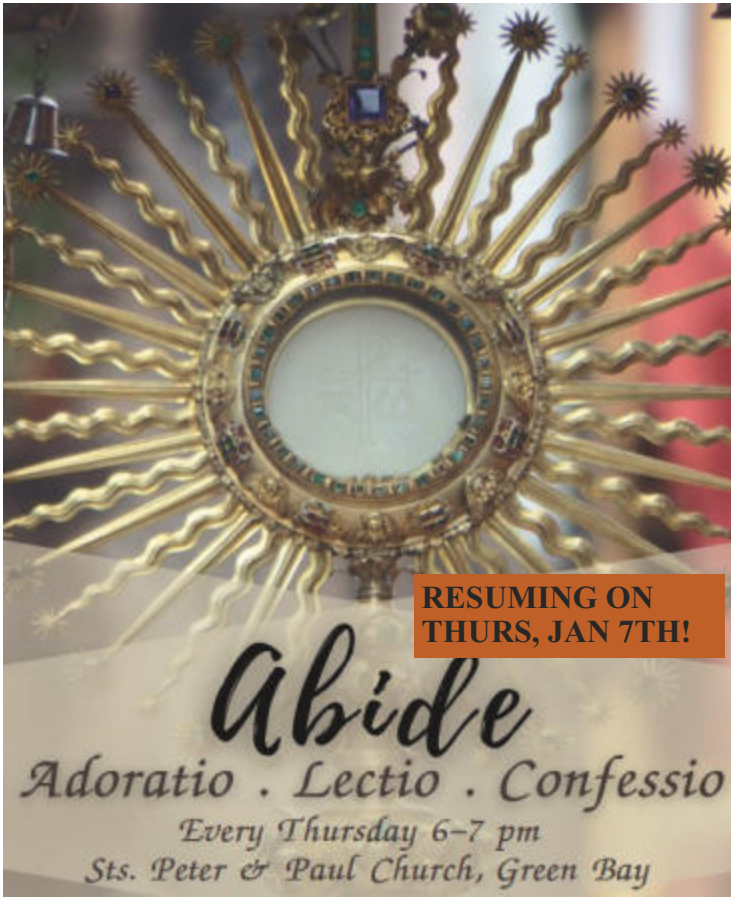

What a great joy to be able to have celebrated this first Christmas with you at this beautiful parish.

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Mary and Joseph have just experienced the overwhelming joy of receiving Jesus into their family life. After all the struggles, finally they're able to carry and hold God in their arms.
