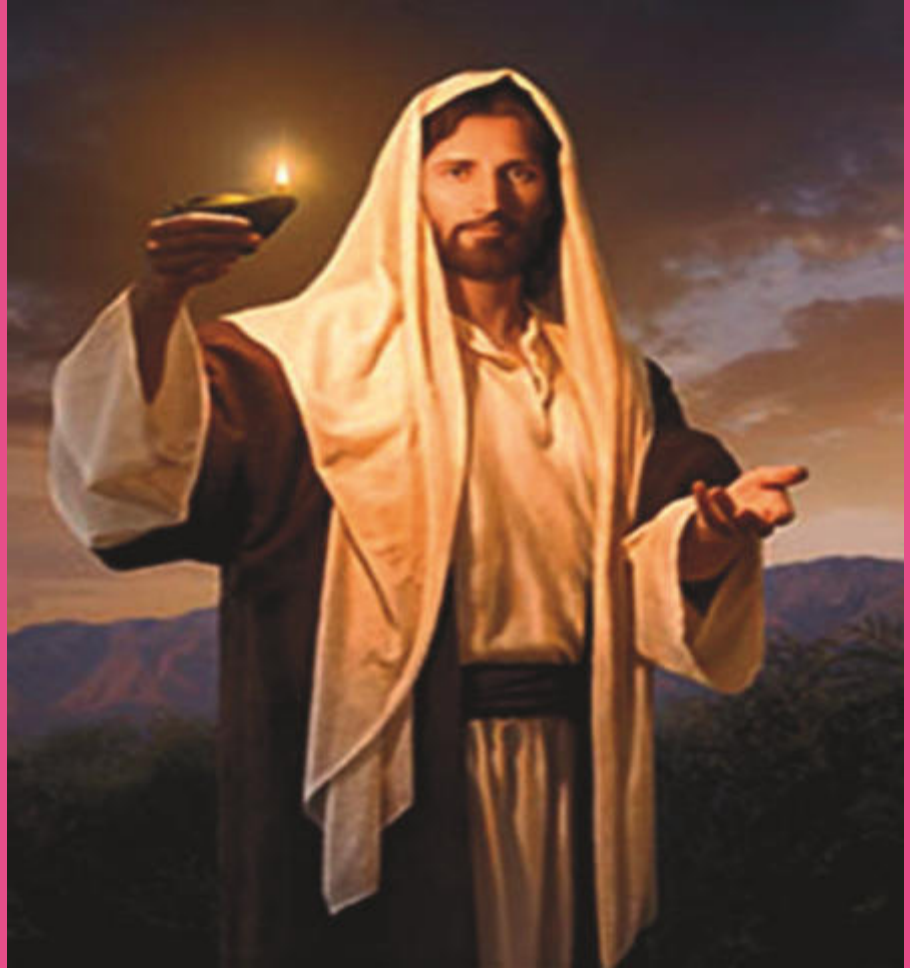

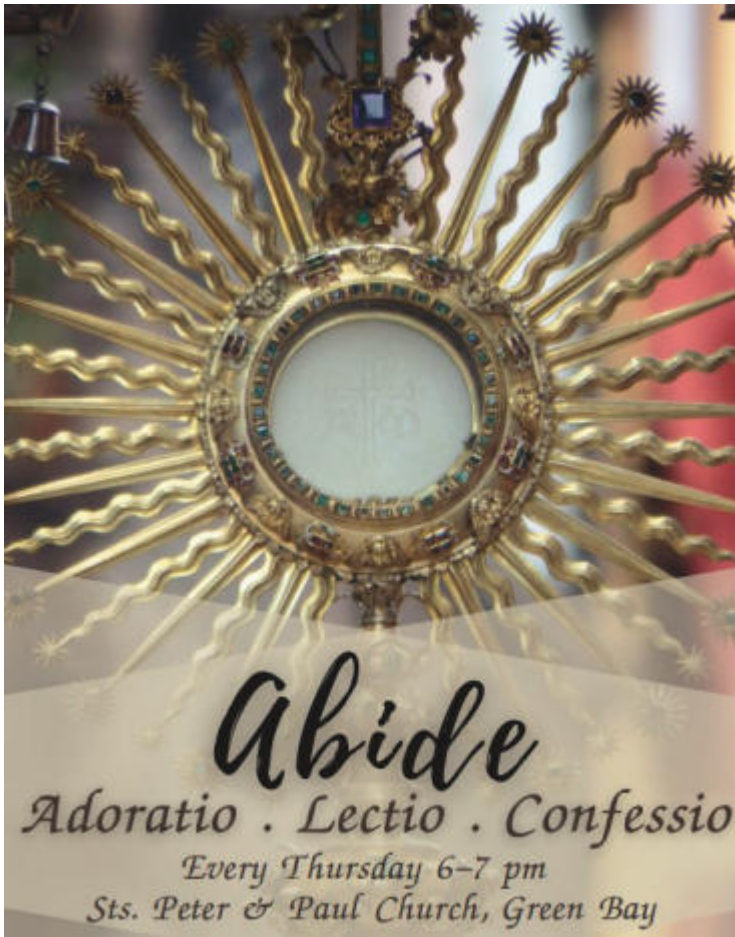

## **THIS YEAR'S EASTER VIGIL Will Be ... **BIG****

With thanks and praise to God for His great blessings, we are DELIGHTED to announce that we expect to Receive 10 People (adults and children) into the Catholic Church during our Easter Vigil this year. We will also have 12 adult Catholics receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation at the same Mass. That's 22 People Receiving Sacraments!

Just so you understand, this means that each of these people will have sponsors, parents and/or spouses, and other family and guests in attendance at the Easter Vigil.

Given our reduced capacity, due to COVID protocols, this means the church may be more full than you normally experience at our weekend Masses.

We will also have our regular Masses on Easter Sunday; 7:30am Spanish, 9:30 English, and 12 Noon Spanish, in case those options are better for you.

***Dear Parish Family,***  
**Blessed Laetare Sunday!**  
**Rejoice, Rejoice!**

We are moving through this Lenten Season and our Church is asking us to rejoice because the end is near!

The end of the Lenten season is near, but the beginning of a life-changing experience begins now and will continue through the rest of our lives.

You could say, “What do you mean, Father?” As we have journeyed through this Lent, we’ve been praying, fasting, and sharing what God has given us with those in need, and as we do so, we’ve been emptying ourselves so that God may fill us up!

Let us move from the darkness of our world to the light of His divinity!

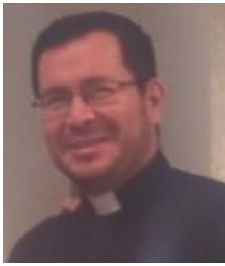
