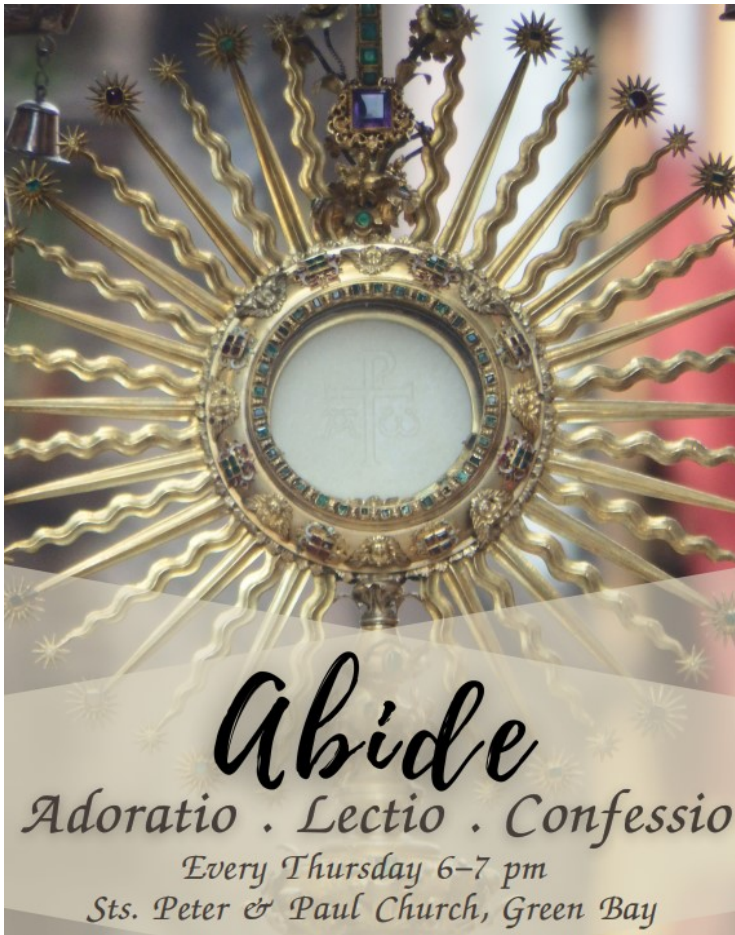

With thanks and praise to God for His great blessings, we are DELIGHTED to announce that we expect to Receive 10 People (adults and children) into the Catholic Church during our Easter Vigil this year. We will also have 12 adult Catholics receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation at the same Mass. That's 22 People Receiving Sacraments!

Just so you understand, this means that each of these people will have sponsors, parents and/or spouses, and other family and guests in attendance at the Easter Vigil.

Given our reduced capacity, due to COVID protocols, this means the church may be more full than you normally experience at our weekend Masses.

We will also have our regular Masses on Easter Sunday; 7:30am Spanish, 9:30 English, and 12 Noon Spanish, in case those options are better for you.

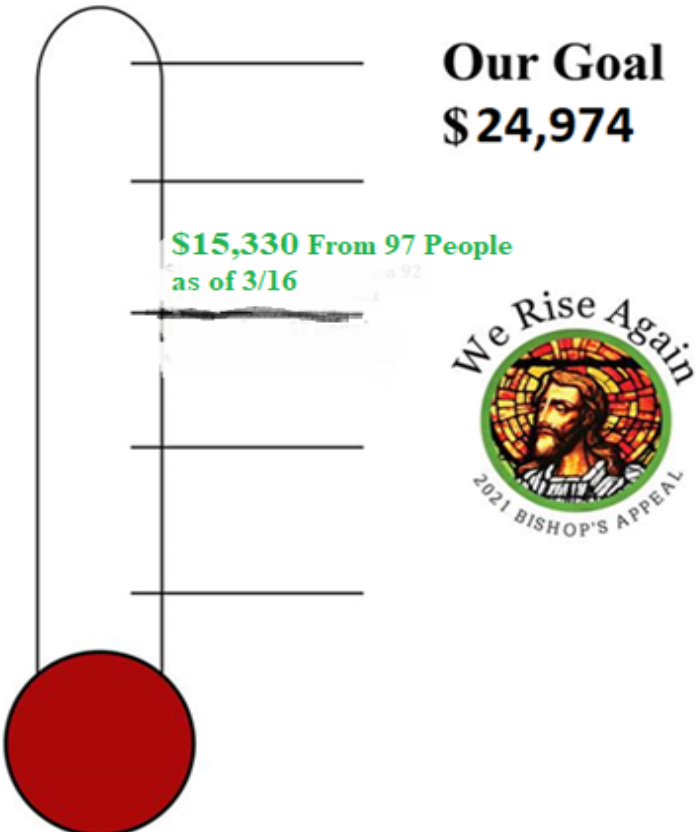

Final Wednesday Faith Formation Classes Are This Coming Wednesday, March 24th



Dear Parish Family,

“...I am troubled now. Yet what Should I say? ‘Father, save me from this hour?’ But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour...” (Jn 12:20-33)

We are quickly approaching the end of the Lenten journey, and Jesus begins to experience the weight of our broken humanity. Yet, in the midst of the struggles He is facing in preparation for the final and complete offering of Himself for our poverty, Jesus remains in communion with His Father.

This divine communion strengthens our Lord as the Father sustains and leads Him to the final battle in the spiritual war for our salvation. Jesus, fully human and fully divine, goes to battle for our sake, and is about to destroy the kingdom of Darkness forever.

Jesus’ decision to give His life for our sake was in no way or shape an easy decision to make. Jesus in His humanity felt the weight of sinfulness but the Father sustained him in the midst of struggle. The voice that came from heaven proves that even in the midst of difficulties, the Father will glorify His name: “I have glorified it and will glorify it again,” the voice was so powerfully heard in the form of thunder. As Jesus gets ready for the final battle on the Cross against Satan himself, He is thinking of us.

The Father shows us that His glory is the total surrender of His son in obedience to Him. We are called to imitate the attitude of Jesus as we try to surrender ourselves and our poverty in obedience to the Father and His will. The Father is glorified when you and I seek Him; allow him to speak to us in the silence of prayer, as we let ourselves be carried and sustained by His merciful love.

Jesus’ end is not the cross but the Resurrection and Ascension into heaven. This is also the end for our sake. We are not called just to be meek and obedient for the sake of dying to ourselves, but for the sake of going and ascending into heaven to the Father as we follow the beloved Son, Jesus Christ.

As we prepare for the final weeks of Lent may we strive to be completely empty of ourselves and truly

humbled, so that we may faithfully follow the courageous example of the Son.

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

“... Ahora que tengo miedo, ¿le voy a decir a mi Padre; ‘Padre, líbrame de esta hora’?...
(Jn 12: 20-33)

Nos acercamos rápidamente al final de la Cuaresma y Jesús comienza a experimentar el peso de nuestra redención. Sin embargo, en medio de las luchas que enfrenta en preparación para su entrega final y completa por nuestra pobreza, Jesús permanece en comunión con su Padre.

Esta comunión divina fortalece a nuestro Señor mientras el Padre lo sostiene y lo conduce a la batalla final en la guerra espiritual por nuestra salvación. Jesús, completamente humano y totalmente divino, va a la batalla por nuestra salvación y está a punto de destruir el reino de las tinieblas para siempre.

La decisión de Jesús de dar su vida por nosotros no fue de ninguna manera una decisión fácil de tomar. Jesús en su humanidad sintió el peso del pecado, pero el Padre lo sostuvo en medio de la lucha. La voz que vino del cielo prueba que incluso en medio de las dificultades, el Padre glorificará su nombre: “Lo he glorificado y lo glorificaré de nuevo”, la voz se escuchó con poder en forma de trueno. Mientras Jesús se prepara para la batalla final contra Satanás en la Cruz, está pensando en nosotros.

El Padre nos muestra que su gloria está en la entrega total de su hijo en obediencia hacia Él. Estamos llamados a imitar la actitud de Jesús mientras tratamos de entregar nuestra pobreza en obediencia al Padre y a su voluntad. El Padre es glorificado cuando tú y yo lo buscamos, le permitimos que nos hable en el silencio de la oración y mientras nos dejamos llevar y sostener por su amor misericordioso.

El fin de Jesús no es la cruz, sino la resurrección y la ascensión al cielo. Este es también nuestro fin. No estamos llamados solo a ser mansos y obedientes por morir a nosotros mismos, sino por ir y ascender al cielo hacia el Padre mientras seguimos a su Hijo amado, Jesucristo.

Mientras nos preparamos para las últimas semanas de Cuaresma, luchemos por estar completamente vacíos de nosotros mismos y seamos verdaderamente humildes para que podamos seguir fielmente el valiente ejemplo del Hijo.
