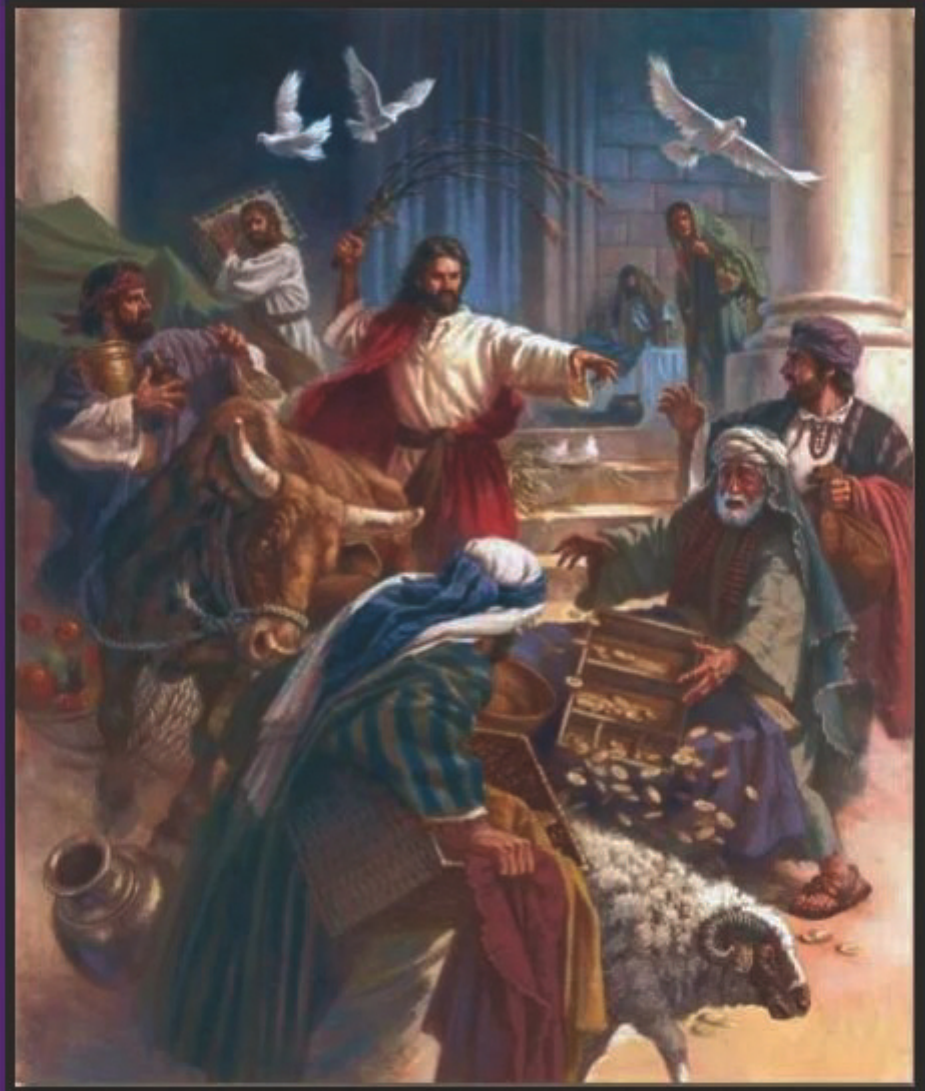

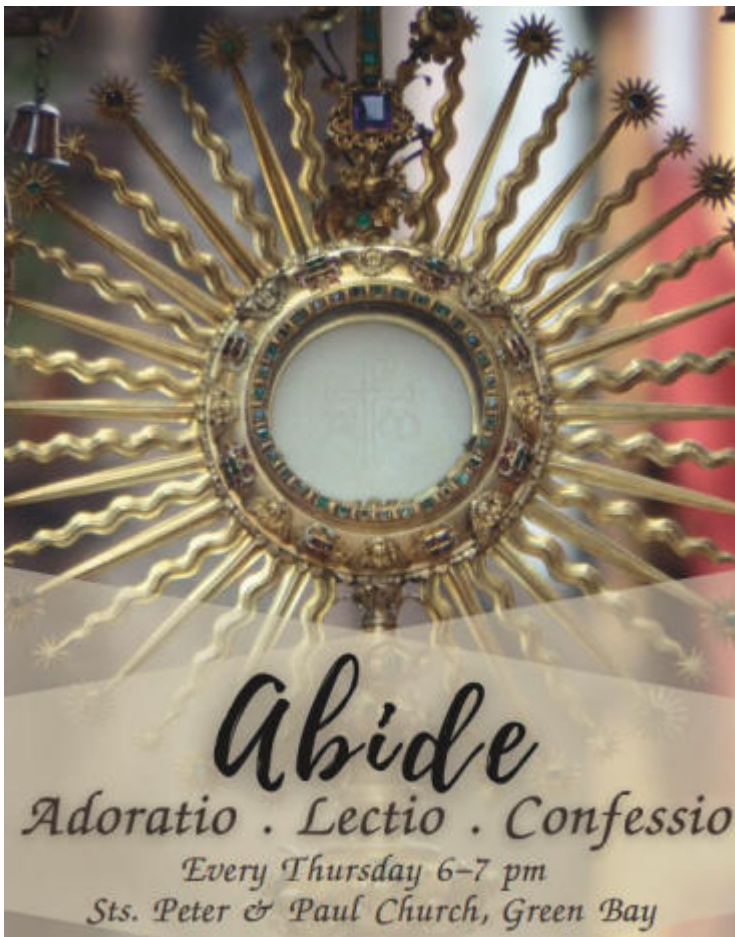

With thanks and praise to God for His great blessings, we are DELIGHTED to announce that we expect to Receive 10 People (adults and children) into the Catholic Church during our Easter Vigil this year. We will also have 12 adult Catholics receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation at the same Mass. That's 22 People Receiving Sacraments!

Just as an "F.Y.I." this means that each of these people will have sponsors, parents and/or spouses, and other family and guests in attendance at the Easter Vigil.

Given our reduced capacity, due to COVID protocols, this means the church may be more full than you normally experience at our weekend Masses.

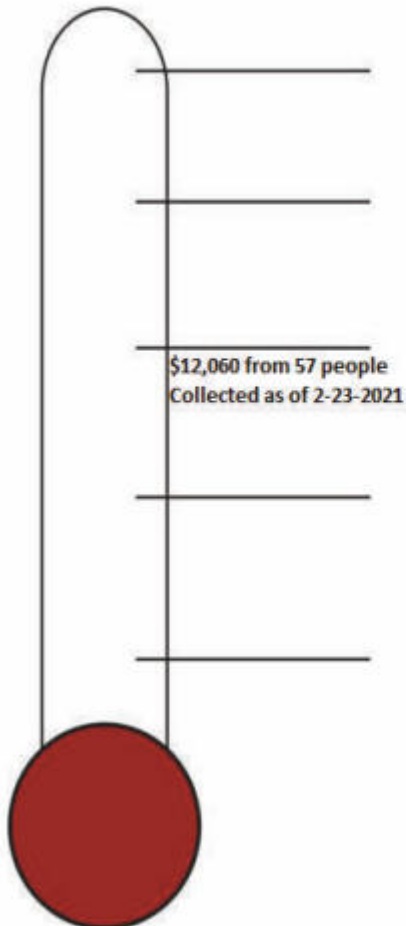

## Dear Parish Family,

As we walk this journey through Lent, we come to experience a side of Jesus that is not always understood, or very often not pondered enough.

Jesus goes to the temple and begins to make a mess (Jn 2:13-25). He overturns tables, spills the money coins, and begins to speak forcefully.

What is happening to the kind and merciful Jesus? Perhaps He is hungry from all the fasting and is in a weird mood? Not at all.

The zeal for His father's house is consuming His heart. His actions come from a place of love for His father and the sacredness of the temple. These images of Jesus coming into the temple and forcefully cleaning and clearing the area from everything that doesn't belong in it, is what He longs to do within our hearts.

This same passion and zeal for His father's house -- which is our hearts and our souls -- consumes His heart. Letting Jesus into our hearts always involves a risk that He'll create a "mess" in our lives, because He will want to get rid of things in our lives that cannot coexist with His presence in our hearts. This is one of the reasons why many are not willing to pursue a relationship with Christ.

Indeed, He is demanding of us; He wants all or nothing. This risk of Jesus making a mess in our lives, is a risk that must be taken by all of us. This is the change that we must undergo this Lent. We need our Lord to help us get rid of the things that do not belong in our hearts.

As Jesus enters our hearts, what is His reaction? What kind of a mess would He create within our souls? Perhaps you've gone through this already and now our Lord is helping you put things in order.

At the end of the day, Jesus was not having a bad day, He wasn't in a weird mood because of all the fasting He had done. No, Jesus' passion and zeal for our hearts, His father's home, came out in this physical reaction. Jesus' anger in today's Gospel is simply a sign that He desires everything and every

space within our hearts and souls. Only then, will we truly be satisfied and fulfilled.

May His passion consume our messiness.

**P.S.** — This coming Easter Vigil we'll have 22 people receiving different sacraments. It will be a true joy to be there with those who will be receiving the power of God through Baptism, Confirmation, and first Communions.

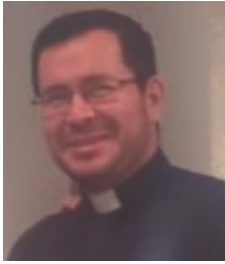


### FORMATION SATURDAY MARCH 13TH

## **Estimada Familia Parroquial,**

A medida que recorremos este camino a través de la Cuaresma, llegamos a experimentar un lado de Jesús que no siempre se

comprende o que, a menudo, no se reflexiona lo suficiente.

Jesús va al templo y comienza a hacer un desastre (Jn 2, 13-25). Vuelca las mesas, tira las monedas al suelo y comienza a hablarles enérgicamente.

¿Qué le está sucediendo al Jesús bondadoso y misericordioso? ¿Quizás tiene hambre por todo el ayuno y está de un humor extraño? Para nada.

El celo por la casa de su padre está consumiendo su corazón. Sus acciones provienen de un lugar de amor por su padre y el carácter sagrado del templo. Estas imágenes de Jesús entrando al templo, limpiando y despejando a la fuerza el área de todo lo que no pertenece a Dios, es lo que Él anhela hacer dentro de nuestros corazones. Esta misma pasión y celo por la casa de su padre que es nuestro corazón, nuestra alma consume su corazón.

Dejar que Jesús entre en nuestros corazones siempre implica el riesgo de que Él haga un "desastre" en nuestras vidas, porque querrá deshacerse de las cosas que no pueden coexistir con su presencia en nuestras vidas. Esta es una de las razones por las que muchos no están dispuestos a buscar una relación con Cristo; de hecho, Él nos exige, quiere ¡todo o nada!

Este riesgo de que Jesús haga un desastre en nuestras vidas, es un riesgo que todos debemos tomar. Este es el cambio que debemos sufrir esta Cuaresma. Necesitamos que nuestro Señor nos ayude a deshacernos de las cosas que no le pertenecen.

Cuando Jesús entra en nuestro corazón, ¿cuál es su reacción? ¿Qué tipo de desastre crearía Él dentro de nuestras almas? Quizás ya hayas pasado por esto y ahora nuestro Señor te está ayudando a poner las cosas en orden. Al final del día, Jesús no estaba teniendo un mal día o estaba de un mal humor debido a todo el ayuno que había hecho.

No, la pasión y el celo de Jesús por nuestros corazones, la casa de su padre, se manifestaron en esta reacción física. El coraje de Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy es simplemente una señal de que Él desea todo y cada espacio dentro de nuestro

corazón y alma. Solo entonces estaremos realmente satisfechos y realizados. Que su pasión consuma nuestro desorden.
