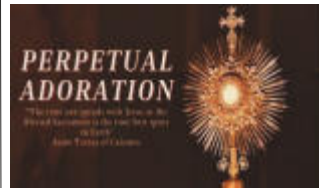
Today as we celebrate the feast of the Ascension, we are reminded that Christ's saving work on earth continues through His disciples.

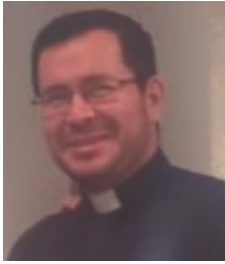
