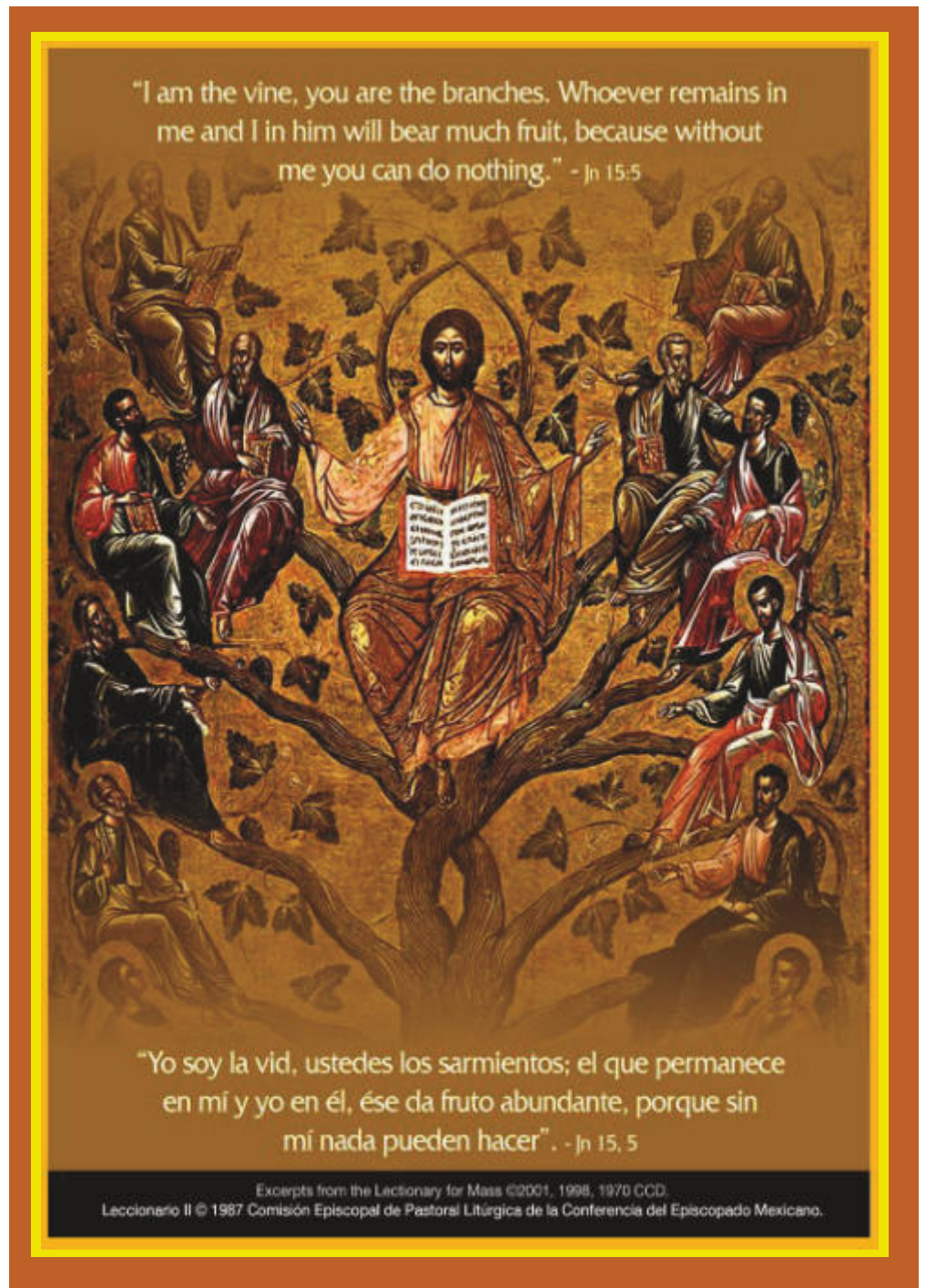

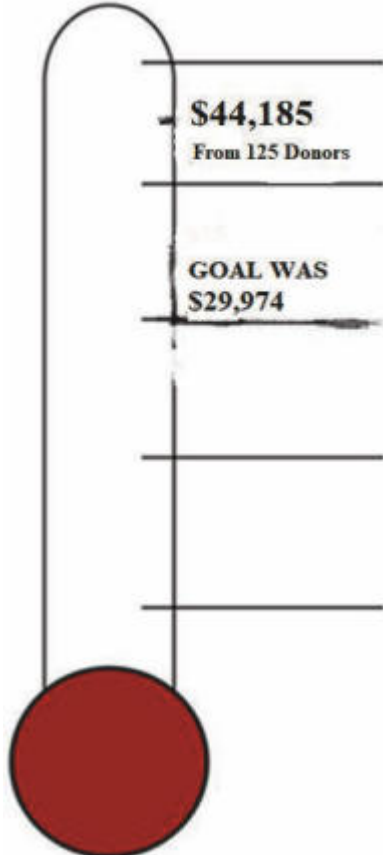

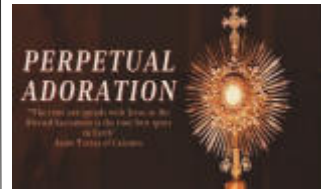
ST. VINCENT de PAUL NEWS

Dear Parish Family,

**“...I am the true vine,
and my Father is the vine
grower...**

**Remain in me, as I remain
in you...I am the vine, you are the
branches...” (Jn 15:1-8).**

What does it mean to remain in Christ? Certainly personal prayer and contact with our Lord on a daily basis is necessary to remain in God. But as Catholic Christians, Jesus has left us such a marvelous gift in His body, the Church. God constantly pours His life into our hearts through the Sacraments. This grace allows us to be so intimately united to -- and in communion with -- Jesus Christ. The Sacraments of the Church allow us to stay rooted in Christ.

Through the sacraments, God pours His divine life upon us so that we may continue to live in right relationship with Him, always moving forward towards our end, which is heaven. In a very special way, through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, our Lord heals our wounds and reconnects us back to the vine, which is Himself. Through this process of healing, we are able to receive our Lord in the Eucharist with a heart and soul made pure through the cleansing of His grace.

This is the beautiful reality of our God, Who goes out of Himself to look for us and bring us back into full communion with Him through the gift of Himself in the sacraments.

And He just simply asks us to stay with Him.

Jesus offers everything to us, so that we may be able to remain in communion with Him. So, when we come to Church for Mass or any other sacrament, we don't do it for the sake of going through rituals and motions in order to achieve something on our own.

We come and place our souls and our hearts at the feet of the Master, so that He is able to unite us and our poverty to the tree of life which is Himself.

Therefore, Mass is not about simply fulfilling a

duty or checking the box. It is about letting the Master, Jesus Christ, wrap our misery with His rich mercy. The sacraments of the Church are such a powerful gift from God for our salvation. The more we come to Him with the desire to know him, love him, and worship him, the more powerful the experience of Jesus Christ present in the Mass or any other Sacrament. May we remain rooted in Christ through the Sacraments that He has given to us for our salvation.

And, Please continue to pray for those who were baptized and confirmed during the Easter vigil!

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

“... Yo soy la verdadera vid , y mi Padre es el viñador ...”

Permanezcan en mí, como yo en ustedes... Yo soy la vid, ustedes los sarmientos...” (Jn 15: 1-8).

¿Qué significa permanecer en Cristo? Ciertamente, la oración personal y el contacto diario con nuestro Señor son necesarios para permanecer en Dios. Pero como cristianos católicos, Jesús nos ha dejado un regalo tan maravilloso en su cuerpo, la Iglesia.

Dios constantemente derrama su vida en nuestros corazones a través de los sacramentos. Esta gracia nos permite estar tan íntimamente unidos y en comunión con Jesucristo. Los sacramentos de la Iglesia nos permiten mantenernos arraigados en Cristo.

A través de los sacramentos, Dios derrama su vida divina sobre nosotros para que podamos seguir viviendo en una relación correcta con Él, siempre avanzando hacia nuestro fin, que es el cielo.

De una manera muy especial a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación, nuestro Señor sana nuestras heridas y nos vuelve a conectar con la vid, que es Él mismo. A través de este proceso de sanación, podemos recibir a nuestro Señor en la Eucaristía con un corazón y un alma purificados mediante la limpieza de Su gracia.

Ésta es la hermosa realidad de nuestro Dios que sale de sí mismo para buscarnos y traernos de regreso a una plena comunión con Él, a través del don de sí mismo en los sacramentos.

Los sacramentos de la Iglesia son un regalo tan poderoso de Dios para nuestra salvación. Cuanto más nos acercamos a Él con el deseo de conocerlo, amarlo y adorarlo, más poderosa es la experiencia de Jesucristo presente en la Misa o en cualquier otro Sacramento.

Ojala que permanezcamos arraigados en Cristo a través de los sacramentos que nos ha dado para nuestra salvación.

Y por favor, Continuemos orando por aquellos que fueron bautizados y confirmados durante la vigilia Pascual.

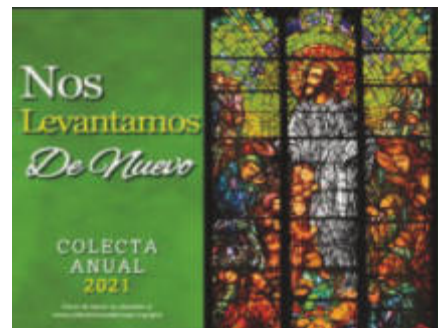

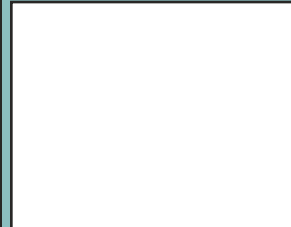
