*Dear Parish Family,
Blessed Solemnity
of the Most Holy
Trinity to you all!*

This is truly an inexhaustible mystery. A God who reveals Himself to His creatures, the human race. Yet, though He reveals Himself to us, He remains hidden in this mystery of being one God in three persons. There is something that we know for sure about this Trinitarian God. We've heard from the first reading that this God, spoke from the midst of the fire, chose His people, and rescued them from slavery with great power and magnificent signs. This same God sent us His beloved Son, Jesus Christ, to demonstrate to us the depth of His love and the awesomeness of His desire to bring us back to Himself.

This Trinitarian God is seeking us with a desperate desire to deliver us from our own places of slavery and struggle. The Father sends the Son, and the Son sends the Fire of Their love -- the Holy Spirit -- to accompany us and help us on our journey towards heaven.

One of the most powerful ways to demonstrate that we are in love with someone is the constant giving of ourselves to them in a real and even sacrificial way. This is precisely what God does with us. The Father not only sent the Son once, but through His body, the Church, Jesus becomes present to us in the Eucharist! Every single day in the world, Jesus comes down from Heaven to give Himself to us and to touch the depths of our hearts. The beauty of our Triune God is that He does expect us to be holy, but He gives us Himself in the Eucharist so that we can actually become holy. The Father's love for us is so great that He gives us all that we need to abide in His love through the constant gift of Jesus in the Eucharist.

The fire of the Father's love in the Holy Spirit is always being poured out upon us with the sole desire to speak to us, to help us turn our hearts to this great mystery of the Holy Trinity and their communion of life.

The Most Holy Trinity wants to share His divine life with us. The Father desires that we receive His beloved Son constantly and reverently, so that He

can help us die to ourselves -- so that He may live in us! The fire of His love desires to consume us, to lead us into the Sacred Heart of the Son where this mystery of the Holy Trinity is a reality!

May we receive His life so that we may surrender to His infinite mercy.

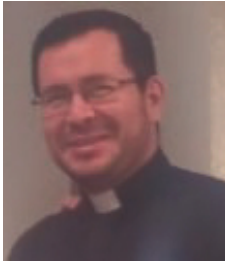
Our format for these Saturdays has changed slightly. We will not have separate input sessions for the various ministries (lectors, communion ministers, etc).

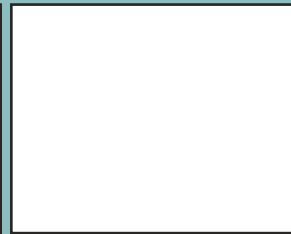

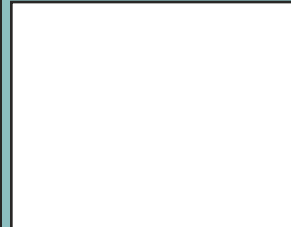
