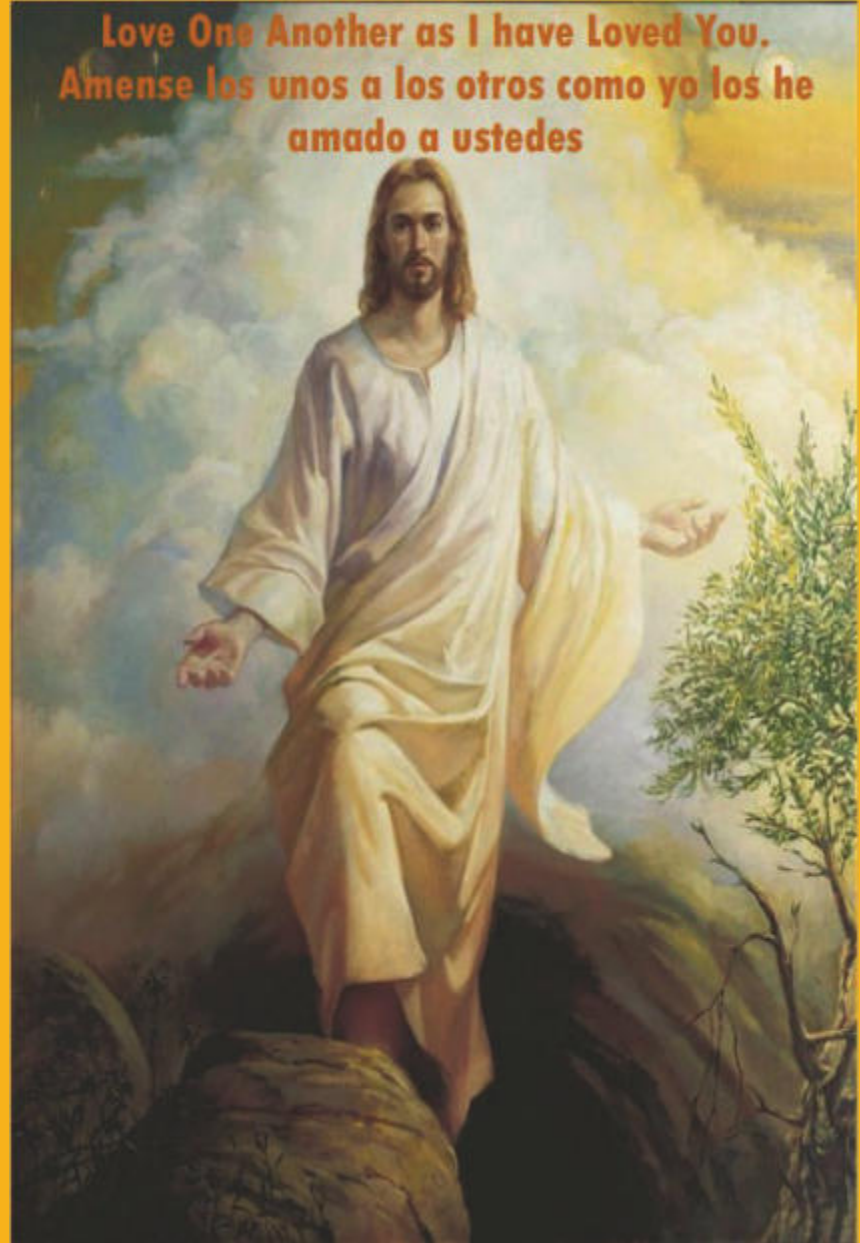

“Reverse” Collection Coming Up Next Two Weekends

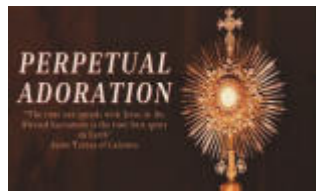

Dear Parish Family,
*Blessed and Happy
Mother's Day to All
Mothers!*

Every single soul has had the privilege to have a mother carry them in their womb. It is such a beautiful privilege that every mother is entrusted with; a unique experience that no one else has or will ever understand.

God, in his creative power, has given us the figure of a mother as a type of His love. Every mother resembles the beauty of God to all humanity. Mothers participate in a very intimate bond with their children since the moment of conception that binds them together. The child needs the mother, and the mother loves until the end; sacrificially giving of themselves always for the good of the child.

In today's gospel we hear Jesus telling us, "As the Father loves me, so I also love you... I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy might be complete... No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends..." (Jn 15:9-17). The Father totally and wholeheartedly loves His beloved Son. This love of the Father gives life and joy to the beloved. It is because of this great love of the Father that the Son is able to respond back in total generosity to the Father.

In a similar way, mothers are able to pour their hearts upon their children since the very first moments of conception. Mothers joyfully endure the sufferings of carrying and forming their children in their wombs, all because they long to love and hold their child in their hands. The mother constantly empties herself in love and service to the child and without requiring the child to love in return. The natural love mothers have for their children is truly extraordinary! God gave mothers the ability to experience an overwhelming experience of love in their hearts in order to be able to love their children from the very first moments.

It is very common to hear how moving and powerful it is for parents--especially mother--when they hold their babies for the first time. Tears rolling down their eyes simply at the opportunity to

hold the one they've suffered for and carried closely for a long time.

God's love for us is truly amazing. The Father loves us with a love beyond all telling. It is a type of love that we can't even begin to comprehend. The child doesn't understand why the mother loves him or her, but yet he or she is simply called to receive the abundance of that love. This is what you and I are called to do with God's love; the moment we receive the abundance of love from our Father, it will change our lives, and our response will be like the one Jesus had; a total giving of ourselves back to God.

Mothers, thank you for showing us in a very concrete way the powerful love of the Father to us.

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

¡Bendito y Feliz Día de la Madre a Todas las Mamás!

Cada alma ha tenido el privilegio de que una madre los lleve en su vientre. Es un privilegio tan hermoso que se le confía a cada madre; una experiencia única que nadie más ha tenido ni comprenderá jamás.

Dios, en su poder creativo, nos ha dado la figura de una madre como un ejemplo de su amor. Toda madre se asemeja a la belleza de Dios. Las madres participan de un vínculo muy íntimo con sus hijos desde el momento de la concepción que los une. El niño necesita a la madre y la madre ama hasta el final; entregándose con sacrificio siempre por el bien del niño.

En el evangelio de hoy escuchamos a Jesús diciéndonos: *“Como el Padre me ama, así los amo yo... les he dicho esto para que mi alegría esté en ustedes y su alegría sea plena... Nadie tiene amor más grande a sus amigos que el que da la vida por ellos...”* (Jn 15, 9-17). El Padre ama total e incondicionalmente a su Hijo. Este amor del Padre da vida y alegría al amado. Es por este gran amor del Padre que el Hijo puede responder con total generosidad al Padre.

De manera similar, las madres pueden derramar su corazón en sus hijos desde los primeros momentos de la concepción. Las madres soportan con alegría los sufrimientos de llevar y formar a sus hijos en el vientre, todo porque anhelan amar y tener a su hijo en sus brazos. La madre se entrega constantemente en amor y servicio al niño y sin exigirle amor a cambio. ¡El amor natural que las madres tienen por sus hijos es verdaderamente extraordinario!

Dios les dio a las madres la posibilidad de vivir una experiencia de amor grandiosa en sus corazones para poder amar a sus hijos desde los primeros momentos. Es muy común escuchar lo conmovedor y poderoso que es para los padres, especialmente la madre, cuando cargan a sus bebés por primera vez.
