*Dear Parish Family,
Blessed and Happy
Feast Day of Ss. Peter
& Paul to All of You!*

This weekend we are celebrating this amazing gift from God. Most every Catholic parish is named after a saint, because we recognize that every saint that ever lived always pursued an intimate relationship with our risen Lord, Jesus Christ.

In their search for God and His abundant mercy, they were able to discover the infinite love that God has for them and all of us. Through their constant surrender to God and their unceasing pursuit of Him, they were able to be authentic mirrors of Christ to the whole world.

We believe that every saint is in heaven adoring and worshipping God, and interceding for us who remain on our journey towards heaven. As we know, heaven is not just an automatic participation reward to those of us who believe in God. We need to imitate the life of the saints in their radical surrender to God, and ultimately, the example of Jesus Christ as He lays down His life for our sake.

St. Peter and St. Paul were two of the strongest pillars of the early Church. St. Peter was the apostle to the Jews and St. Paul the apostle to the Gentiles. Through their efforts and by constantly pouring themselves out in service to God, God used them to bring His gospel to the whole world. Both of these men were certainly not perfect, but they had an authentic desire for God and His truth. This desire led them to a powerful encounter with our Lord.

St. Peter encountered the mercy of Jesus Christ in the midst of his suffering as he betrayed and denied Jesus. In the midst of the tears, he tasted his own failure and brokenness, so that later on he would be able to receive Jesus' forgiveness. His broken heart was longing to receive the refreshing mercy of Jesus.

St. Paul, on the other hand, had a powerful experience with the Risen Lord, perhaps like no one else. His experience was so real, so powerful, that it opened His mind and His heart to understand the Gospel in a totally different way. St. Paul realized that Jesus was not against the Law and the Prophets as he once thought; he realized that Jesus is the

fulfilment of the Law and the Prophets, and the end goal for all of us. The encounter with Christ and His body, the Church and His followers, changed the heart of St. Paul and re-ordered his heart to desire to lead others to God in Jesus Christ.

These are saints who struggled in their own humanity, but through the grace of God they were able to encounter the rich mercy of Jesus Christ and surrender to Him. These saints are our patron saints whom God has given to us as our powerful intercessors in heaven. It is their goal--and it should be ours as well--that we long for the intimate encounter with the Risen Lord. May we pray for this most gracious gift that we too may be healed and transformed by the powerful encounter with Jesus Christ.

Ss. Peter and Paul, pray for us and our holiness. May our hearts burn with desire and longing to experience the burning mercy of Jesus Christ in the midst of our own poverty. Amen. Please come and share a good time at our celebration in thanksgiving and gratitude to almighty God for the gift of intercession of Ss. Peter and Paul.

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

¡Bendita y feliz fiesta de San Pedro y San Pablo para todos ustedes!

Este fin de semana celebramos este maravilloso regalo de Dios. La mayoría de las parroquias católicas llevan el nombre de un santo porque reconocemos que cada santo que vivió, siempre buscó una relación íntima con nuestro Señor Jesucristo. En su búsqueda de Dios y su abundante misericordia pudieron descubrir el amor infinito que Dios tiene por ellos y por todos nosotros. Mediante su constante entrega a Dios y su incesante búsqueda de Él, pudieron ser auténticos espejos de Cristo para el mundo entero. Creemos que todo santo está en el cielo adorando a Dios e intercediendo por nosotros que permanecemos en nuestro camino hacia la gloria. Como sabemos, el cielo no es una recompensa automática para los que creemos en Dios; necesitamos imitar la vida de los santos en su entrega radical a Dios y, en última instancia, el ejemplo de Jesucristo al dar Su vida por nosotros.

San Pedro y San Pablo fueron dos de los pilares más fuertes de la Iglesia primitiva. San Pedro fue el apóstol de los judíos y San Pablo el apóstol de los gentiles. A través de sus esfuerzos y al derramarse constantemente en servicio a Dios, Él los usó para llevar Su evangelio a todo el mundo. Ambos hombres ciertamente no eran perfectos, pero tenían un auténtico deseo por Dios y Su verdad. Este deseo los llevó a un encuentro poderoso con nuestro Señor. San Pedro encontró la misericordia de Jesucristo en medio de su sufrimiento después de traicionar y negar a Jesús. En medio de las lágrimas, probó su propio fracaso y su fragilidad, para luego poder recibir el perdón del Señor. Su corazón quebrantado anhelaba recibir la misericordia refrescante de Jesús.

San Pablo, por otro lado, tuvo una experiencia poderosa con el Señor Resucitado, tal vez como nadie más. Su experiencia fue tan real, tan poderosa, que abrió Su mente y Su corazón para entender el Evangelio de una manera totalmente diferente. Ahora, San Pablo se dio cuenta de que Jesús no estaba en contra de la Ley y los Profetas

como alguna vez pensó. Se da cuenta de que Jesús es el cumplimiento y el fin de nuestras vidas. El encuentro con Cristo y su cuerpo, la Iglesia y Sus seguidores, cambió el corazón de San Pablo y re-ordenó su corazón para desear llevar a otros a Dios, a Jesucristo.

Estos son los santos que lucharon en su propia humanidad, pero por la gracia de Dios pudieron encontrar la infinita misericordia de Jesucristo y entregarse a Él. Estos santos son nuestros santos patronos que Dios nos ha dado como nuestros poderosos intercesores en el cielo. Es su objetivo y debe ser el nuestro también, que anhelemos el encuentro íntimo con el Señor Resucitado. Oremos por este regalo de la mayor gracia para que nosotros también podamos ser sanados y transformados por el poderoso encuentro con Jesucristo.

San Pedro y San Pablo, rueguen por nosotros y por nuestra santidad. Que nuestros corazones ardan de deseo y anhelo de experimentar la misericordia de Jesucristo en medio de nuestra propia pobreza.

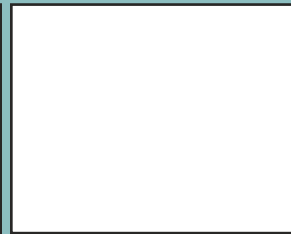

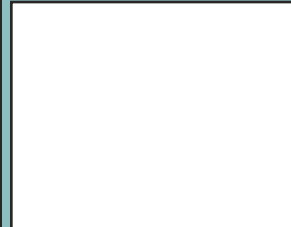
