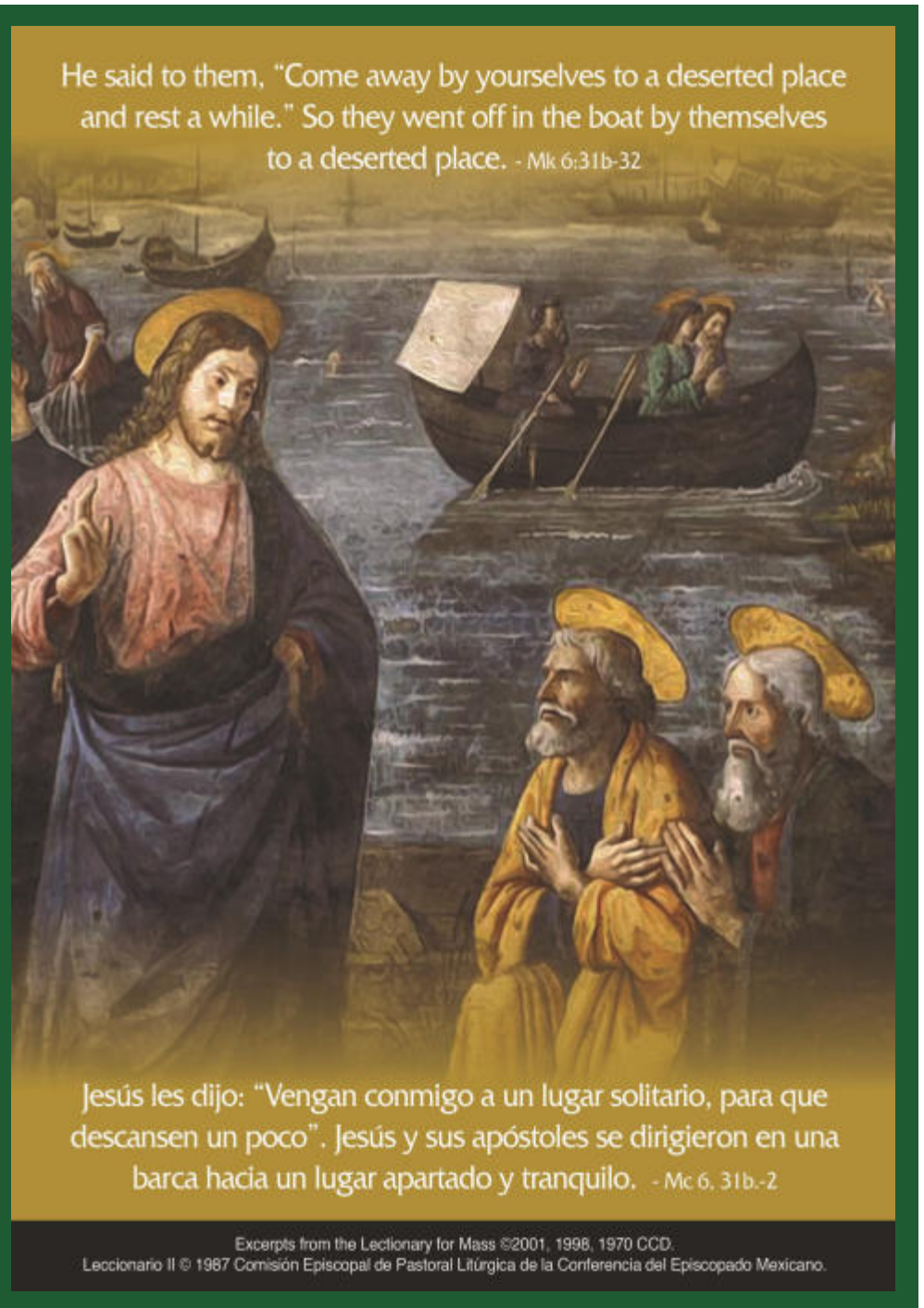

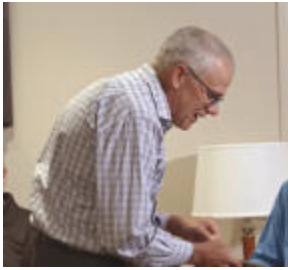

The KC's have begun a campaign to bring a new ultrasound machine to the St. Gianna Clinic.

The clinic, is located in DePere and serves Wisconsin and beyond with ethical, Christian based care for the whole family. As most parishioners know, our very own Doctor Scott

Stillwell and his wife Cindy, both serve on the staff of St. Gianna Clinic.

Ultrasound machines have proven to be front-line equipment in helping to save the lives of the unborn, and in aiding families who want to conceive a child.

“Since we began our fund raising committee back in February, the Knights here at SSPP have raised all but \$12,880 of the \$61,784 needed to purchase the new ultrasound machine for the St Gianna Clinic”, said Grand Knight Joe Uhyrek—a parishioner here at Ss. Peter & Paul.

Dear Parish Family,

Summer is quickly flying by!

Our hope and prayer is that you're able to enjoy the Summer with your family and friends as much as possible in the presence of God our Father.

On this 16th Sunday of ordinary time, the Gospel gives us one of the most compassionate images for us to ponder and reflect upon. It is the image of Jesus' heart moving with pity for His people (Mk 6:34).

This Sacred Heart of Jesus beats with love, compassion and mercy for us. Every time that He gazes upon us, His heart beats with passion and is moved to compassion for us and our needs. This is the love with which we are gazed upon every single moment of the day.

The fact is, that it doesn't matter how many times I or anyone else tells you about the tremendous love of the Father for us if we are not encountering this love in a real, personal way in prayer!

Jesus gives us the model for us to follow in this same gospel. The apostles gathered with Jesus and related everything to Him. Jesus took them aside, to a deserted place for them to rest and be with Him. We are also invited everyday to relate to Him our work, our worries, our anxieties, everything that we are doing for Him and for our families.

Jesus also invites us to come away with Him to a deserted place to be with Him and rest in His bosom.

This deserted place where Jesus invites us is not necessarily a physical place, but it is found in the silence and solitude of our hearts. It's a matter of us finding a place where we can be alone with Him -- to try to contemplate His Sacred Heart moving with pity for us as He gazes at us and our poverty.

One of the most powerful places for us to contemplate His Sacred Heart is at our Eucharistic chapel, for He is physically present waiting to see and contemplate us in our humanity.

May we ask our Lord for the grace to see and experience His heart moving with pity for us. May we never be afraid to ask our Lord to allow us to experience His presence and glorious mercy.

This is what will allow us to change and be transformed by His beautiful love. Ask Him to come and show you His heart, and let your heart be moved in prayer and contemplation by His love.

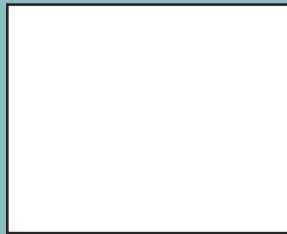

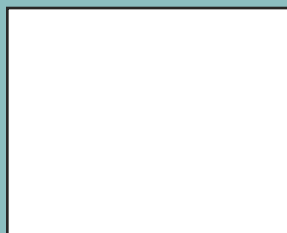
