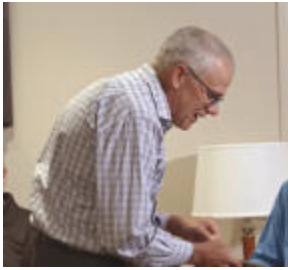

The KC's have begun a campaign to bring a new ultrasound machine to the St. Gianna Clinic.

The clinic, is located in DePere and serves Wisconsin and beyond with ethical, Christian based care for the whole family. As most parishioners know, our very own Doctor Scott

Stillwell and his wife Cindy, both serve on the staff of St. Gianna Clinic.

Ultrasound machines have proven to be front-line equipment in helping to save the lives of the unborn, and in aiding families who want to conceive a child.

“Since we began our fund raising committee back in February, the Knights here at SSPP have raised all but \$12,880 of the \$61,784 needed to purchase the new ultrasound machine for the St Gianna Clinic”, said Grand Knight Joe Uhyrek—a parishioner here at Ss. Peter & Paul.

Fr. Martins will visit our Parish on Saturday, August 7th, 10am-2pm, with his “Treasures of

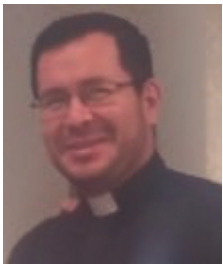

Dear Parish Family,

The Church gives us the great opportunity to dive deeper into the mystery of Eucharist, which is the summit of our faith, by allowing us

to hear the Bread of Life Discourse from the 6th chapter of St. John's gospel.

It begins with this Sunday, and it will continue throughout a good portion of August. There is a tremendous need for us to carefully listen to the word of God as Jesus tries to speak about and demonstrate the powerful gift that He would entrust to the apostles for our sake. The gift of His own body, blood, soul and divinity which, in a real and significant way, is Jesus Christ Himself who comes in pursuit of us.

It almost sounds scandalous to say that the Lord of all creation, the maker of heaven and earth, leaves heaven to come down to encounter us at Holy Mass, and not only that, but that He becomes so vulnerable as to place the totality of Himself in a piece of bread for our sake. It sounds too good to be true.

We all know we are not worthy of such a powerful privilege, but yet He so faithfully comes in search of His beloved children, you and me. This powerful gift of the Eucharist, Jesus Christ Himself, is something that we haven't fully understood yet. It seems impossible to believe that a host can become God Himself by His own power and merit.

This God, Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, is what we are able to receive every single Mass if we know we are in a state of grace to receive Him.

Similarly, every time we go to pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament in our Church or our eucharistic chapel, we come before our Lord who stays on this earth for our sake so that we may be able to come before Him and unload our burdens and gratitude. This is Jesus Christ Himself who is waiting for you and me to come, see, and spend time with Him in silent prayer before Him in the Eucharist.

Our Chapel is still in need of adorers so that we can go back to 24/7 adoration. For some reason, people, God's beloved children, do not want to spend time before Him. Only if we would experience Jesus' powerful gaze upon us, we'd all be trying to run to be under His life-giving gaze.

If you have experienced the merciful face of Jesus in the Eucharist, help us spread the good news about it so that we can fill all the slots for our chapel, so that every single moment of the day, every day, at least a single soul may benefit from Jesus' merciful love. Este poderoso regalo de la Eucaristía, Jesucristo mismo, es algo que no hemos entendido completamente, aún parece imposible creer que un anfitrión pueda convertirse en Dios mismo por Su propio poder y mérito. Este Dios, Jesucristo en la Eucaristía, es lo que podemos recibir en cada misa si sabemos que estamos en estado de gracia.

Del mismo modo, cada vez que vamos a orar frente al Santísimo Sacramento en nuestra Iglesia o nuestra capilla eucarística, nos presentamos ante nuestro Señor que permanece en esta tierra por nosotros para que podamos acercarnos a Él y descargar nuestras cargas y gratitud. Este es Jesucristo mismo quien te está esperando para que vengas a verlo y a pasar tiempo con Él en oración silenciosa ante Él en la Eucaristía.

Nuestra Capilla todavía necesita adoradores para que podamos volver a la adoración 24 horas al día, los 7 días de la semana. Por alguna razón, las personas, los amados hijos de Dios no quieren pasar tiempo delante de Él; dense la oportunidad
