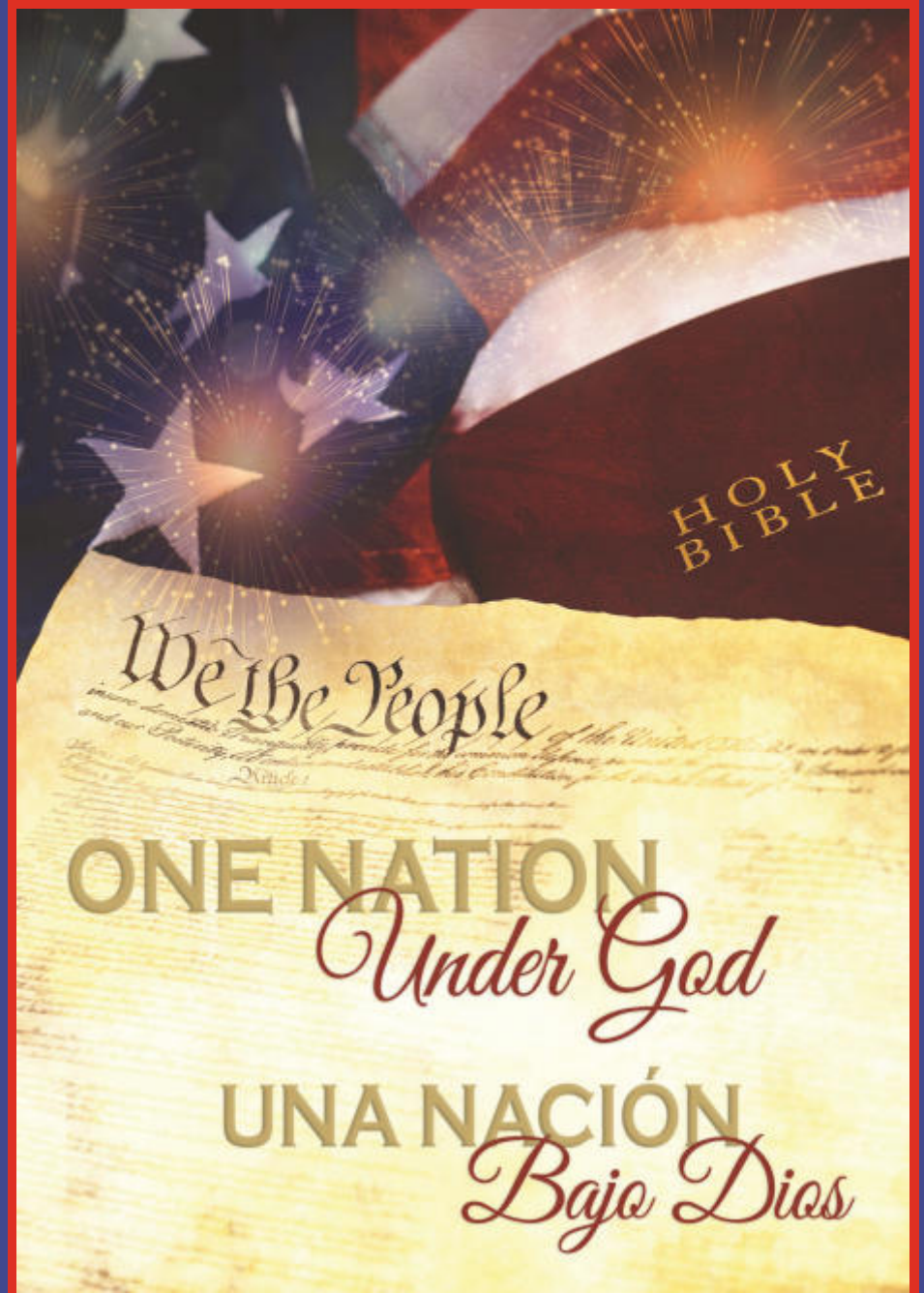

Dear Parish Family,

I would like to offer a sincere word of gratitude to all of you who helped us celebrate our Pastoral Feast day of Ss. Peter & Paul.

As you may know, the whole focus of it was not in the financial gain, but in building and connecting our community since we've gone through some difficult months lately. It was wonderful to see and witness people from both communities coming together, working together, chatting, and getting to know each other. It also provided an opportunity for our new families to get to know each other and the rest of our parish family. So, from the bottom of my heart, thank you for your faithfulness to almighty God, and your willingness to serve Him and His people in our parish.

This Sunday we hear that Jesus "was amazed" at seeing the lack of faith of the people in His own town. I've often tried to ponder what this must have looked like. What must have gone through Jesus' heart as He is trying to rescue them from their own darkness to lead them back to the Father?

No doubt there must have been a tremendous sadness in Jesus' heart knowing that people weren't open to receive from the abundance of His heart. The fact of the matter is that Jesus continues to look at us as individuals and as a parish family.

It'd be worth pondering what would go through Jesus' heart as He gazes at us? What does He see? What quality of faith would He find in our hearts?

There is always the risk of getting discouraged, since we are not perfect and not always faithful to God. But, through the example of St. Paul, God shows us that His "grace is sufficient... for power is made perfect in weakness..." (2 Cor 12:7-10).

God is not unfair. It is He himself who desires to place the gift of faith in our hearts so that we may believe in Him. In the midst of our weakness, the Father longs to pour His mercy into us so that we may be strengthened! He just wants us to be open to the possibility of letting ourselves be overwhelmed by the power of His love.

May we cry out to God in the midst of our weaknesses and lack of perfect faith, so that He may pour His grace upon us.

As we grow in our faith and as a parish family, the hope is that when Jesus looks at us, He may be happy to see our willingness to surrender our poverty at His feet, so that we may receive in abundance what He longs to share with us.

May we be like St. Paul, "for when I am weak, then I am strong" (2 Cor 12:10).

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

Me gustaría ofrecer un sincero agradecimiento a todos ustedes que nos ayudaron a celebrar nuestra Fiesta Pastoral de San Pedro y San Pablo.

Como sabrá, el enfoque no era la ganancia financiera, sino en la construcción y conexión de nuestra comunidad, ya que últimamente hemos pasado por algunos meses difíciles.

Fue maravilloso ver y presenciar la interacción personal que se dio entre ambas comunidades al reunirse, conocerse, charlar y trabajar juntas. También brindó una oportunidad para que nuestras nuevas familias se conocieran entre sí y al resto de nuestra familia parroquial. Así que desde el fondo de mi corazón, gracias por su fidelidad a Dios todopoderoso y su disposición a servirle a él y a su pueblo en nuestra parroquia.

Este domingo escuchamos que Jesús “estaba extrañado de la incredulidad” al ver la falta de fe de la gente en su propio pueblo. A menudo he tratado de reflexionar sobre cómo debió haber sido esto. ¿Qué debió haber pasado por el corazón de Jesús mientras trataba de rescatarlos de su propia oscuridad para llevarlos de regreso al Padre? Sin duda, debe haber habido una tremenda tristeza en el corazón de Jesús al saber que la gente no estaba abierta a recibir de la abundancia de Su corazón. El hecho es que Jesús continúa mirándonos, como individuos y como familia parroquial.

Valdría la pena reflexionar sobre lo que pasaría por el corazón de Jesús mientras nos mira. ¿Qué ve Él? ¿Qué calidad de fe encontraría en nuestros corazones? Siempre existe el riesgo de desanimarnos porque no somos perfectos y no siempre somos fieles a Dios. Pero, con el ejemplo de San Pablo, Dios nos muestra que “su gracia nos basta ... porque su poder se manifiesta en la debilidad ...” (2 Co 12, 7-10).

Dios no es injusto. Es él mismo quien desea poner el don de la fe en nuestro corazón para que creamos en él. En medio de nuestra debilidad, el Padre anhela derramar Su misericordia en nosotros para que seamos fortalecidos. Solo quiere que

estemos abiertos a la posibilidad de dejarnos abrumar por el poder de su amor.

Ojala que clamemos a Dios en medio de nuestras debilidades y falta de fe perfecta, para que derrame Su gracia sobre nosotros. A medida que crecemos en nuestra fe y como familia parroquial, la esperanza es que cuando Jesús nos mire, pueda estar feliz de ver nuestra disposición a entregar nuestra pobreza a sus pies para que podamos recibir en abundancia lo que Él anhela compartir con nosotros.

Busquemos ser como San Pablo, “porque cuando soy débil, entonces soy fuerte” (2 Co 12, 10).
