

We cannot accept new participants after Saturday, October 30th.




Youth Choir Reminder:

Dear Parish Family,

This week we were blessed with the presence of Robert Reynebeau, one of our new seminarians for the diocese. I pray and hope that you

have an opportunity to hear his story, and listen to how he is hearing the Lord calling him to give his life for the sake of the Kingdom of God and His bride, the Church. Rob's response to the call of God is a current example of how Jesus continues to call us for the sake of healing us, and then to send us on mission just like He did with Bartimaeus in the Gospel today.

Our heavenly Father promised His infinite love to us, and His profound desire to gather His children back to Himself. Through the prophet Jeremiah, the Father reminds us that *He brings us back to Himself... that He will gather us from all the ends of the earth... He gave us His promise to console us because we were in tears... He will lead us because He is a Father to us (Jer 31:7-9).*

This promise became a reality to Bartimaeus, whom in the midst of his blindness and misery, experienced Jesus' invitation to come to Him. I pray that we can ponder Bartimaeus' exciting reaction and his eagerness to respond to Jesus' invitation. He threw aside his cloak not just put it aside, but threw it in excitement and eagerness. Though he was blind, he sprang up from the floor. His excitement was so great, that he couldn't wait another minute! In his reaction we can see an explosiveness of joy in his heart and body. He was responding to Jesus' invitation and came to Him. Then our Lord goes on to heal him. Just like the prophet Jeremiah had promised, the Father sent the Son to embrace the illness and poverty of Bartimaeus. He experienced the Father's healing embrace and His healing mercy, and Jesus led him, just like the Father had promised.

We are all called to respond to Jesus' invitation with excitement or joy. Knowing that it is the Father Himself who wants to console us, heal us, and bring us back to Himself in the Kingdom of Heaven. The fact that you are here and reading this, is because Jesus Himself has called you and continues to do so. How are we responding to His call and invitation? We must be willing to throw

everything aside and spring up with eagerness to go see our Lord. His question to Bartimaeus is the same question He is asking us; What do you want me to do for you?

May we spend hours or days pondering and discerning Jesus' voice and invitation to come to Him. Let's be honest and real with our Lord, and tell Him what we need and desire. Let us ask Him to make His voice so loud and profound that we can't avoid it, but rather listen to it and be obedient to the Lord's invitation. We are not the one seeking God, it is the Father who seeks His children... God Himself who placed a desire for Him in our hearts. May we respond to it joyfully, excitingly, and eagerly.

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

Esta semana fuimos bendecidos con la presencia de Robert Reynebeau, uno de nuestros nuevos seminaristas.

Espero que hayan tenido la oportunidad de escuchar su historia y escuchar cómo el Señor lo está llamando a dar su vida por el reino de Dios y Su esposa, la Iglesia. La respuesta de Rob al llamado de Dios es un ejemplo actual de cómo Jesús continúa llamándonos con el fin de sanarnos y luego enviarnos en misión tal como lo hizo con Bartimeo en el evangelio de hoy.

Nuestro Padre celestial nos prometió Su amor infinito y Su profundo deseo de reunir de nuevo Sus hijos con Él. A través del profeta Jeremías, el Padre nos recuerda que Él nos trae de regreso a sí mismo ... que Él nos reunirá de todos los confines de la tierra ... Él nos dio Su promesa de consolarnos porque estábamos llorando ... Él nos guiará porque Él es un Padre para nosotros (Jer 31: 7-9).

Esta promesa se hizo realidad para Bartimeo, quien en medio de su ceguera y miseria, experimentó la invitación de Jesús a venir a él. Le pido a Dios que podamos reflexionar sobre la emocionante reacción de Bartimeo y su entusiasmo por responder a la invitación de Jesús. Tiro a un lado su manta, no solo la dejó a un lado, sino que la tiró con energía y entusiasmo. Aunque estaba ciego, saltó del suelo. ¡Su entusiasmo era tan grande que no podía esperar ni un minuto más! En su reacción podemos ver una explosión de alegría en su corazón y en su cuerpo.

Respondió a la invitación de Jesús y se acercó a Él. Entonces nuestro Señor pasa a sanarlo: tal como lo había prometido el profeta Jeremías, el Padre envió al Hijo a abrazar la enfermedad y la pobreza de Bartimeo. Experimentó el abrazo sanador del Padre y Su misericordia sanadora, y Jesús lo guió, tal como el Padre lo había prometido.

Todos estamos llamados a responder a la invitación de Jesús con entusiasmo y alegría. Sabiendo que es el Padre mismo quien quiere consolarnos, sanarnos y traernos de regreso a Él al Reino de los Cielos.

El hecho de que estés aquí leyendo esto se debe a que Jesús mismo te ha llamado y continúa haciéndolo. ¿Cómo estamos respondiendo a su llamado e invitación? Debemos estar dispuestos a tirar todo a un lado y saltar con ansias para ir a ver a nuestro Señor.

Su pregunta a Bartimeo es la misma pregunta que él nos hace a nosotros; ¿Qué quieres que haga por ti?

Ojala que pasemos horas y días meditando y discerniendo la voz de Jesús y la invitación a venir a Él. Seamos honestos con nuestro Señor, y digámosle lo que necesitamos y deseamos. Pidamos que haga Su voz tan fuerte y profunda que no podamos evitarla, sino que la escuchemos y seamos obedientes a la invitación del Señor.

No somos nosotros los que buscamos a Dios, es el Padre el que busca a Sus hijos... Es Dios mismo, quien puso un deseo por Él en nuestros corazones para que podamos responderle con alegría, emoción y entusiasmo.
