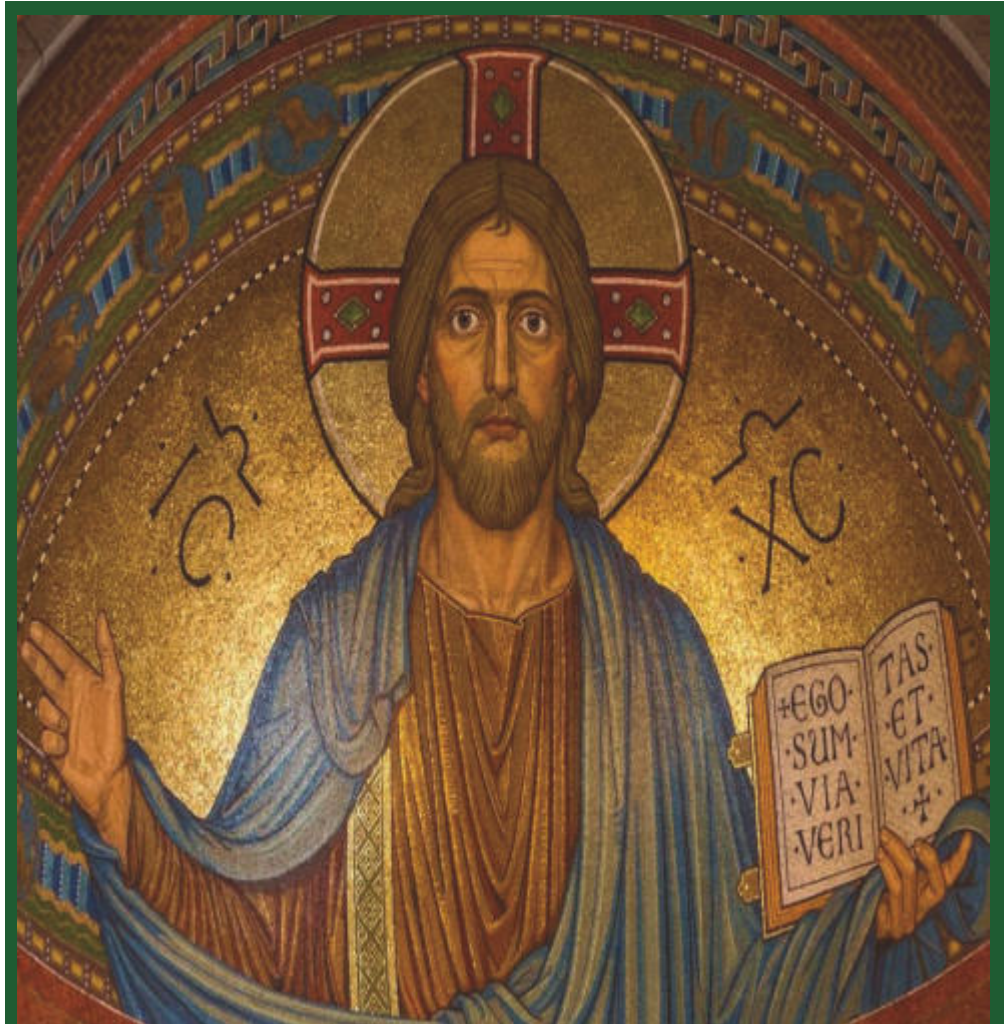

#### Adoration Chapel History—Part One

“Nothing is Impossible with God”

On, July 1st, 1993, Msgr. Roy Klister arrived at Saints Peter & Paul Parish as pastor. Within a week of his arrival, a small group of faithful parishioners asked “Could we have Perpetual Adoration here?” Msgr. Klister said that he wouldn't have known what his answer would have been if it wasn't for his time spent at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD, where he experienced a deep appreciation of Eucharistic Devotion.

There he discovered that the dioceses in which there was regular Eucharistic devotion and adoration were the ones with the largest callings for the priesthood, and the quality of the candidates were especially impressive. Msgr. Klister didn't need to be convinced of the value of promoting adoration of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament.

#### Historia de la Capilla de la Adoración, Parte 1

¿El 1 de julio de 1993, Mons. Roy Klister llegó a la parroquia San Pedro & San Pablo como párroco. Una semana después de su llegada, un pequeño grupo de fieles feligreses preguntó: "¿Podríamos tener la Adoración Perpetua aquí?" Mons. Klister dijo que no habría sabido cuál habría sido su respuesta si no fuera por el tiempo que pasó en el Seminario Mount St. Mary en Emmitsburg, MD, donde experimentó un profundo aprecio por la Devoción Eucarística.

Allí descubrió que las diócesis en las que había devoción y adoración eucarísticas habituales eran las que tenían mayores vocaciones al sacerdocio, y la calidad de los candidatos era especialmente impresionante. Mons. Klister no necesitaba estar convencido del valor de promover la adoración de Jesucristo en el Santísimo Sacramento.

In today's gospel, we hear Jesus speaking about the greatest of all commandments; *"Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is Lord alone! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength... (and) you shall love your neighbor as yourself..."* Mk 12:29-34.

We understand a command to be something we are told to do by another person. Why would God command us to love Him? It is not because God is in need of attention or love that He is asking us to love Him with our whole heart, soul, mind and strength. God is in need of no one and nothing! He is complete, fulfilled, and satisfied, but He does desire to share Himself with us.

And so it is with us; every time we listen to God and we actually try to love Him with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength, we too are filled with joy and love.

When the soul of a human being pursues God with its whole heart, we are drawn deeper into the mystery of love, the fount of life which satisfies completely our deepest longings and desires.

This week, may we ask our Lord for the grace to seek and love Him with our whole heart, soul, mind, and strength so that we may taste His goodness and it may radically change our lives!

No one and nothing will ever satisfy our souls and hearts like the love of God will!
