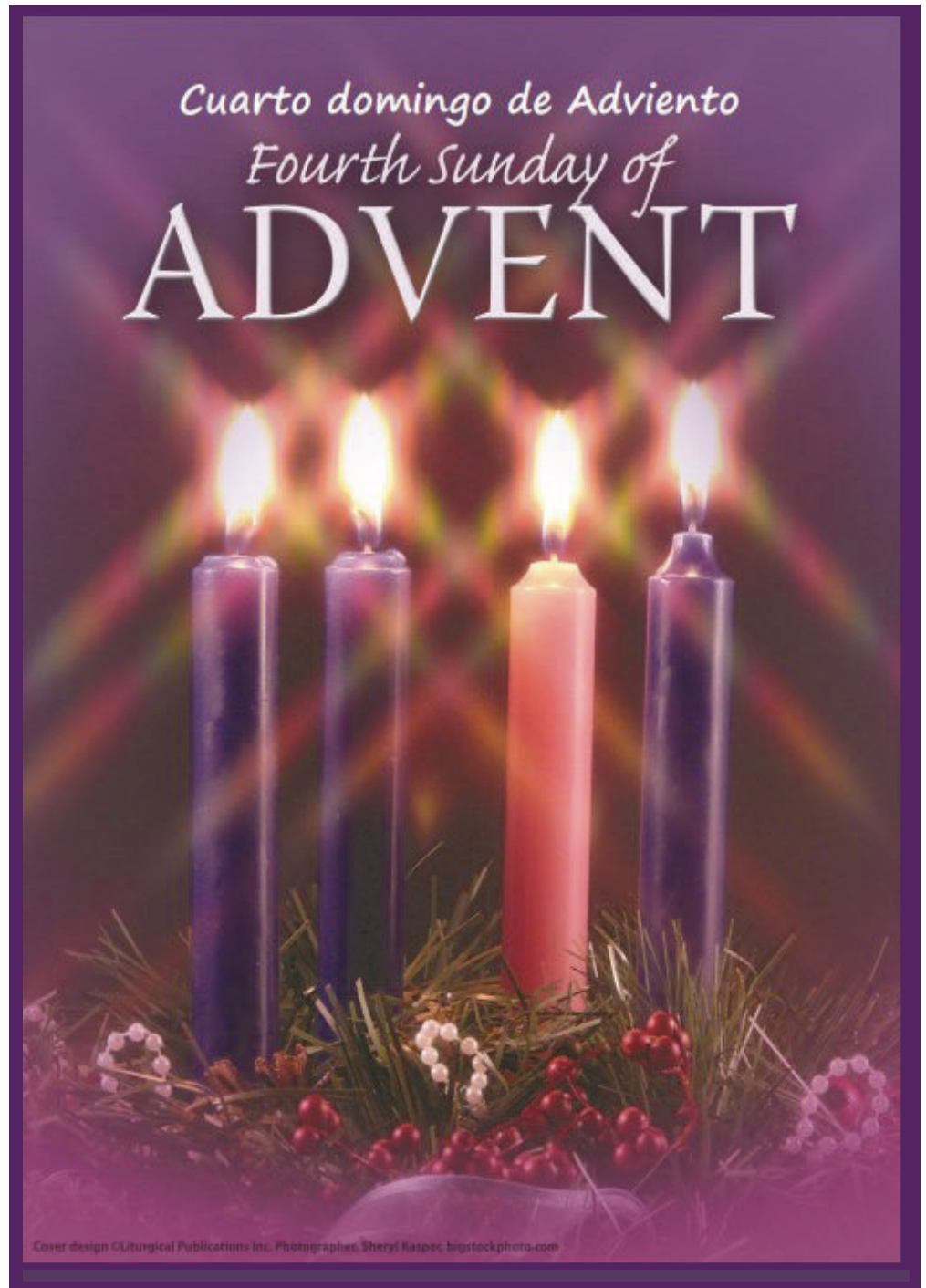

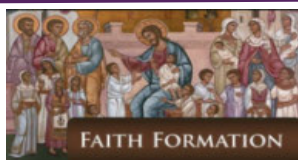

Adoration Chapel History—Continued

1999, Continued... On the first weekend of Nov., 1999, Fr. Deluca spoke at 14 masses. Sign up sheets were placed in pews and volunteers stood ready to take names and phone numbers of new adorers. The goal was to fill 24 hours each day, seven days a week with hopefully two people for each hour. That was a staggering number of 336 people. Fr. Deluca was putting out a call to the faithful to take another step in their faith to become even more intimate with their Savior.

While recruitment seemed insurmountable in itself, the building plans for the physical Adoration Chapel appeared even more laborious; electricians, plumbers, carpenters...

1999, continuación... El primer fin de semana de noviembre de 1999, el P. Deluca habló en 14 misas. Se colocaron hojas de inscripción en las bancas y los voluntarios estaban listos para tomar nombres y números de teléfono de los nuevos adoradores.

El objetivo era llenar las 24 horas del día, los siete días de la semana, con dos personas por cada hora. Ese fue un número asombroso de 336 personas. P. Deluca estaba haciendo un llamado a los fieles para que dieran un paso más en su fe para intimar aún más con su Salvador.

Si bien el reclutamiento parecía insuperable en sí mismo, los planos de construcción de la Capilla de la Adoración física parecían aún más laboriosos; electricistas, fontaneros, carpinteros ...

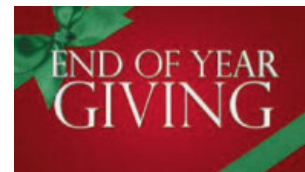

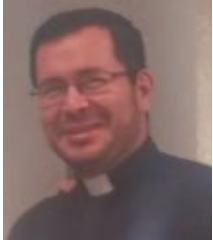
