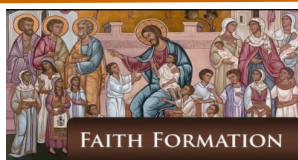

1999, Continued... Plans were made to renovate a small room in the south-east corner of the lower level of the church for the future Adoration Chapel. With the help of Deacon Jim Asmuth from Neenah, the chapel plans were drawn. They were approved by the parish council and the city.

With “Sign Up” Sunday bringing in hundreds of adorers from our parish and surrounding churches, and the construction completed and secured, our Christ The King Adoration Chapel was ready for the First Exposition and dedication on Dec. 12th, 1999.

This occurred shortly after Fr. Tom Farrell was assigned to our parish. He, along with Msgr. Roy Klister, celebrated the event with mass followed by a procession with the Blessed Sacrament to the new chapel.

Dear Parish Family,

I pray and hope that you are having a blessed Christmas full of God's joys and blessings in Jesus Christ!

We've just celebrated Jesus' birthday yesterday, and now we are pondering the meaning of family life. Modern times are challenging the structure of family life. It seems that society has lost the meaning of family and family structure. It is not surprising that when a society casts God aside, as if He didn't matter or existed, society as a whole suffers. Hence, secular society doesn't understand the real meaning of family and its structure.

Family structure—a marriage between a man and a woman, given to each other in love that is total and sacrificial—is able to welcome children through their physical complementarity. The mutual love of a man and woman reflects so powerfully the mystery of the Holy Trinity; it becomes a communion of persons who seek the good and well-being of the other.

The family structure is given by God to humanity so that we may ponder, and in a mysterious way, spouses may live that mystery of love that the Holy Trinity experiences! Spouses are meant to pour themselves out in love for the sake of the other, just like the Father pours Himself totally and completely for the good of the beloved Son.

The children between spouses become the tangible sign of the love between them that keeps and binds them together. This mystery of children resembles the reality of the Holy Spirit, the love between the Father and the beloved Son that unites them in a single substance. It is the beauty of children in the family that is meant to bring the spouses to an intimate union of hearts and minds.

It is our gift that we have the beauty of the Holy Family—Jesus, Mary and Joseph—to ponder this day. The Holy Family became the human reflection of the mystery of the Holy Trinity. Mary and Joseph follow the will of God with total obedience, they love each other with selfless love, and are willing to sacrifice themselves for the sake of their child, Jesus Christ.

This is the model that spouses are meant to follow:

Prayerful people, seeking to do the will of God and loving each other with a selfless love and being willing to sacrifice themselves for each other and their children. When spouses are willing to follow God and His will for their family, they not only experience authentic joy and peace, but also the mighty help of God so that they can love each other and sustain their love beyond their own imagination.

This gift of the Holy Family is for us to reflect on the beauty of who God is. The more we reflect on the life of the Holy Family, the closer we'll get to God. Family is one of the greatest treasures that God gave to humanity, may we embrace it and ask for the grace to live it properly and faithfully with His mighty help.

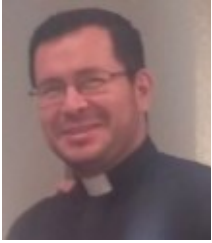
