Today, Palm Sunday, we begin this beautiful journey of Holy Week!

This is the week that has transformed the course of humanity! The God-made-man has become one of us, so that He can break through the closed doors of heaven!

Today, you will experience that, as we bang on the doors of the Church with the processional cross! It is a beautiful rite that makes us aware of what God has done!

By becoming man, God has broken through the doors of heaven – so that we may be able to enter paradise!

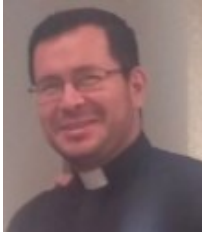

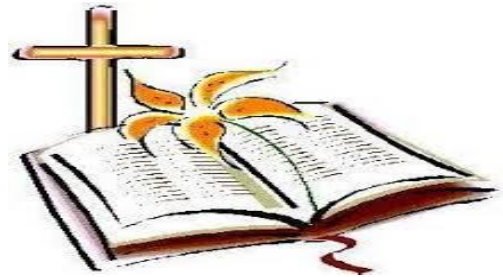
Aparta la fecha, el 26 de junio estaremos celebrando nuestra fiesta pastoral.
