Faith Formation/Religious Education News

Registration is open for all grades, 1-12, in our Wednesday Faith Formation program. Classes will begin on September 28th, and will continue on Wednesdays from 5:00pm to 6:15pm.

Please remember that these classes are not only for those who need to prepare for sacraments. All children need to learn and grow in our Catholic Faith, even before and after receiving particular sacraments.

Fr. José is strongly encouraging every parish family with children to enroll their children in our program. While every family is expected to pay what they can (regular fee will be \$55 this year), we will never turn away any child due to lack of funds.

Registration can be completed online through our parish website, or in person at the parish office.

Registration will remain open until September 14th, when it will close for the 2022-23 religious education year.
