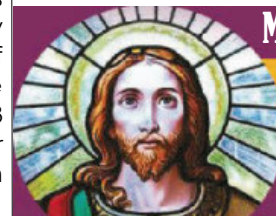

## Sharing the light of Christ

In this Sunday's gospel, Jesus appears in Galilee for the first time preaching the good news. At the Lake of Tiberias, he calls simple fishermen who drop everything to follow him. Their immediate and whole-hearted response teaches us what it means to repent and believe in the good news. It means encountering the person of Jesus, following him and leaving everything behind.

Believing in the good news means having an encounter with Jesus Christ. The apostles didn't leave their families, homes, and jobs because they believed in an ideal. Rather it was coming face-to-face with Jesus that moved them. Meeting Jesus changed everything for them.

We cannot have the same face-to-face encounter with Jesus that the apostles enjoyed. But we are still able to meet the Risen Lord when we read the Bible, receive the Sacraments, and serve our sisters and brothers who are his living body. We are not on fire for our faith because we like to follow rules. Rather it is because we have met and fallen in love with Jesus Christ. This personal relationship with him that we have through faith and the ministry of the Church drives everything that we are about.

Finally, believing in the good news means leaving everything behind. The apostles could not follow Jesus and stay fishermen. We cannot follow Jesus and continue to live the same way we did before. When we choose to follow Jesus, some things will have to stay behind. We may have to end friendships because they lead us to bad behavior. We may have to change our business practices because they are deceitful. We will all be called to live simpler lives so that we will have more left over to give to the poor. Some will even be called to sell everything and to give their lives totally over to Jesus in religious life. For all of us, gaining Jesus will mean the loss of something or someone we love. It was that way for the apostles, and it continues to be that way for us. There is no other way if we are to put our lives in the hands of our loving Father.

The Kingdom of God is among us. The Risen Lord is present in our midst. His presence soothes our fears. His words touch and heal our hearts. His Sacraments nourish and strengthen us. We meet him in one another, and we fall in love with the one who died for us. We gladly leave everything behind to follow after the one our heart longs for. Despite the difficulties, we know that it is the path of life. We walk with ever growing strength because we have met Jesus and our lives can never be the same.

En el evangelio de este domingo, Jesús aparece en Galilea por primera vez predicando las buenas nuevas. En el lago de Tiberíades, llama a simples pescadores que dejan todo para seguirlo. Su respuesta inmediata y sincera nos enseña lo que significa arrepentirse y creer en las buenas nuevas. Significa encontrar la persona de Jesús, seguirlo y dejar todo atrás. Creer en las buenas nuevas significa tener un encuentro con Jesucristo. Los apóstoles no dejaron a sus familias, hogares y trabajos porque creían en un ideal. Más bien fue encontrarse cara a cara con Jesús lo que los conmovió. Conocer a Jesús cambió todo para ellos. No podemos tener el mismo encuentro cara a cara con Jesús que disfrutaron los apóstoles. Pero todavía podemos encontrarnos con el Señor resucitado cuando leemos la Biblia, recibimos los sacramentos y servimos a nuestras hermanas y hermanos que son su cuerpo vivo. No estamos encendidos por nuestra fe porque nos gusta seguir las reglas. Más bien es porque nos hemos encontrado y nos hemos enamorado de Jesucristo. Esta relación personal con él que tenemos a través de la fe y el ministerio de la Iglesia impulsa todo lo que somos. Finalmente, creer en las buenas nuevas significa dejar todo atrás. Los apóstoles no podían seguir a Jesús y permanecer pescadores. No podemos seguir a Jesús y continuar viviendo de la misma manera que lo hacíamos antes. Cuando elegimos seguir a Jesús, algunas cosas tendrán que quedarse atrás. Es posible que tengamos que terminar con las amistades porque nos llevan a un mal comportamiento. Es posible que tengamos que cambiar nuestras prácticas comerciales porque son engañosas. Todos seremos llamados a vivir vidas más simples para que nos quede más para dar a los pobres. Algunos incluso serán llamados a vender todo y a entregar sus vidas totalmente a Jesús en la vida religiosa. Para todos nosotros, ganar a Jesús significará la pérdida de algo o alguien que amamos. Fue así para los apóstoles, y sigue siendo así para nosotros. No hay otra manera si vamos a poner nuestras vidas en las manos de nuestro Padre amoroso. El Reino de Dios está entre nosotros. El Señor resucitado está presente en medio de nosotros. Su presencia calma nuestros temores. Sus palabras tocan y sanan nuestros corazones. Sus sacramentos nos nutren y fortalecen. Lo encontramos el uno en el otro, y nos enamoramos de Aquel que murió por nosotros. Con mucho gusto dejamos todo atrás para seguir después de lo que nuestro corazón anhela. 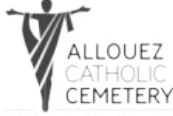
