Dear Parish Family,

Blessed Divine Mercy to you all!

The Lord has shown His mercy to us all as He died on the Cross, betrayed and abandoned by His friends. Now, we hear our Lord going to see His friends, those who abandoned Him on the Cross. Jesus goes and wishes peace upon them. The risen Lord is willing to show them His precious wounds so that they know it is Him. Divine mercy is not only willing to forgive, but is also willing to go and seek them out. The betrayed seeks the betrayer. Incredible to believe, but it's true!

Let's reflect on Divine Mercy for a moment. Some use it as an excuse to justify our actions, thinking that God is merciful therefore He'll forgive me if I do x, y or z. Others approach our Lord with sincere trust that indeed He is merciful and forgives our sins. But, very often we aren't willing to show the same mercy and compassion to those around us. It is extremely difficult to love like our Lord loves us. Some may even say that it is close to impossible. But our willingness to imitate His love must be there as we approach Him.

As we meditate on His divine mercy, how are we to approach Him? For those of us who approach Him, begging for mercy, we must do it with a total desire to love Him, a sincere conviction to leave our sinful ways behind and embrace a life of prayer, penance and virtue. Our Lord has defeated death and destroyed the kingdom of darkness. Any action, attitude, or behavior that is sinful on our end, belongs to the kingdom of darkness. We can't approach our Lord longing for life, for His divine Mercy, if we live in sin. Life and death can't commingle in the same soul. The Father of mercies, the author of life, desires the totality of our souls. If we dare to ask our Lord for mercy, we must have a sincere and honest disposition to leave every sin behind us with the help of God. God is merciful but He is also just. The justice of God requires that we truly humble ourselves and are willing to change our lives.

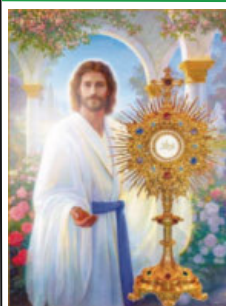
Yes, God in His infinite love wants to pour out His divine mercy on us all. But we must be willing to change our lives, otherwise His mercy on us does nothing. The Father sent His son to die for us on the Cross so that we may know to what degree we are loved. We know we are loved, we also know the areas where we struggle. If we truly want God's mercy, we must approach Him with a sincere willingness to change our lives. God is merciful, we are broken, are we willing to change our lives with His help?

Pero, muy a menudo, no estamos dispuestos a mostrar la misma misericordia y compasión a quienes nos rodean. Es extremadamente difícil amar como nos ama nuestro Señor. Algunos incluso pueden decir que es casi imposible. Pero nuestra voluntad de imitar su amor debe estar ahí cuando nos acercamos a él. Mientras meditamos en Su divina misericordia, ¿cómo debemos acercarnos a Él? Quienes nos acercamos a él, implorando misericordia, debemos hacerlo con un deseo total de amarlo, una convicción sincera de dejar atrás nuestros caminos pecaminosos y abrazar una vida de oración, penitencia y virtud. Nuestro Señor ha vencido a la muerte y destruido el reino de las tinieblas. Cualquier acción, actitud o comportamiento que sea pecaminoso de nuestra parte, pertenece al reino de las tinieblas. 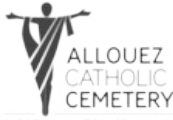
