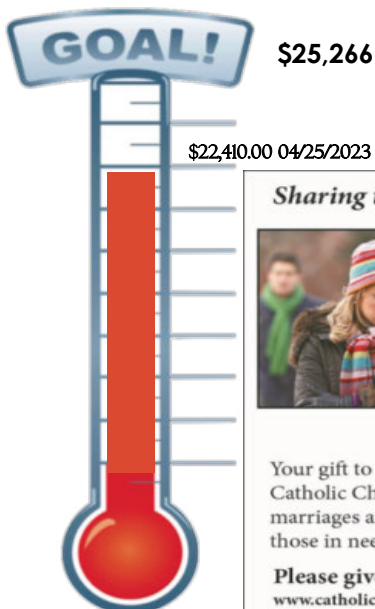

Dear Parish Family,  
 Thank you so much for all your support, love, prayers, and generous acts of kindness and compassion towards me. I've received a great number of cards, emails, calls, and messages from all of you – and for that, I'm deeply grateful. Thank you for watching out for me and sincerely sharing your love of Jesus Christ with me. I've been truly humbled and moved to the heart as I read your messages and cards. I can't thank God enough for His great love, compassion and mercy towards me and all of us, and also for your presence in my life. I hope to be able to be back soon and recover as soon as possible. Please continue to pray for me, my recovery, and all of our parish members who are ill and struggling in their lives.

This Sunday we are reminded that Jesus came into our world so that we may have life and have it in abundance (Jn 10:10). We are the sheep of the great Shepherd Whom God has made both Lord and Christ (Acts 2:14). How often do we forget who Jesus is and what He wants for us? Very often, people in our society, and even some within the Church, want to domesticate our Lord Jesus Christ to reduce Him to a mere friend or nice person. Jesus Christ is both Lord and Christ, man and God, full of power, glory and majesty. This is the same Jesus to Whom we pray, to Whom we go for our needs and petitions. This Jesus, anointed with the power of the Holy Spirit, is the One longing to speak to us, Who desires that we recognize His voice. This power of the Holy Spirit is what Jesus longs to bestow upon us over and over again, every time we speak to Him, every time we are in need, every time we take refuge in Him. This is the life that Jesus wants us to have in abundance. The life of the Holy Spirit, always faithful to the Father, obedient in everything to almighty God, and always willing to do His will and not our own. This will lead us to authentic happiness.

In the first reading, as Peter speaks boldly and is filled with the Holy Spirit, people are cut to the heart. People were convicted of their mistake and turned towards God. The voice of God convicts us of our sinfulness and our own crimes against God and neighbor. When we listen to the voice of God, it leads us to repentance; then we dare to beg for mercy. As the voice of God cuts to our hearts, it makes us fully aware of our misery, and we must choose to either stay in that misery, or choose to be led out of it by God the Almighty Father. Choosing life and walking out of our misery—literally turning our messiness to the mercy of God—is what we call a conversion of heart. Unfortunately, very often we stay in a shallow relationship with God, not allowing Him to enter fully into our hearts because we know that He'll demand everything, especially our darkness and sinfulness. Be not afraid of casting into the deep in our relationship with our Lord! Let God cut to our hearts and convict us of our struggles so that we can leave them behind with the help of His grace. Jesus wants life in abundance for us, Jesus and sin do not commingle well. Life in abundance means letting Jesus help us completely remove sin from our lives. To whose voice do I listen, the Shepherd or the thief?

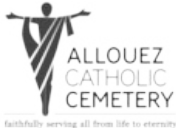
