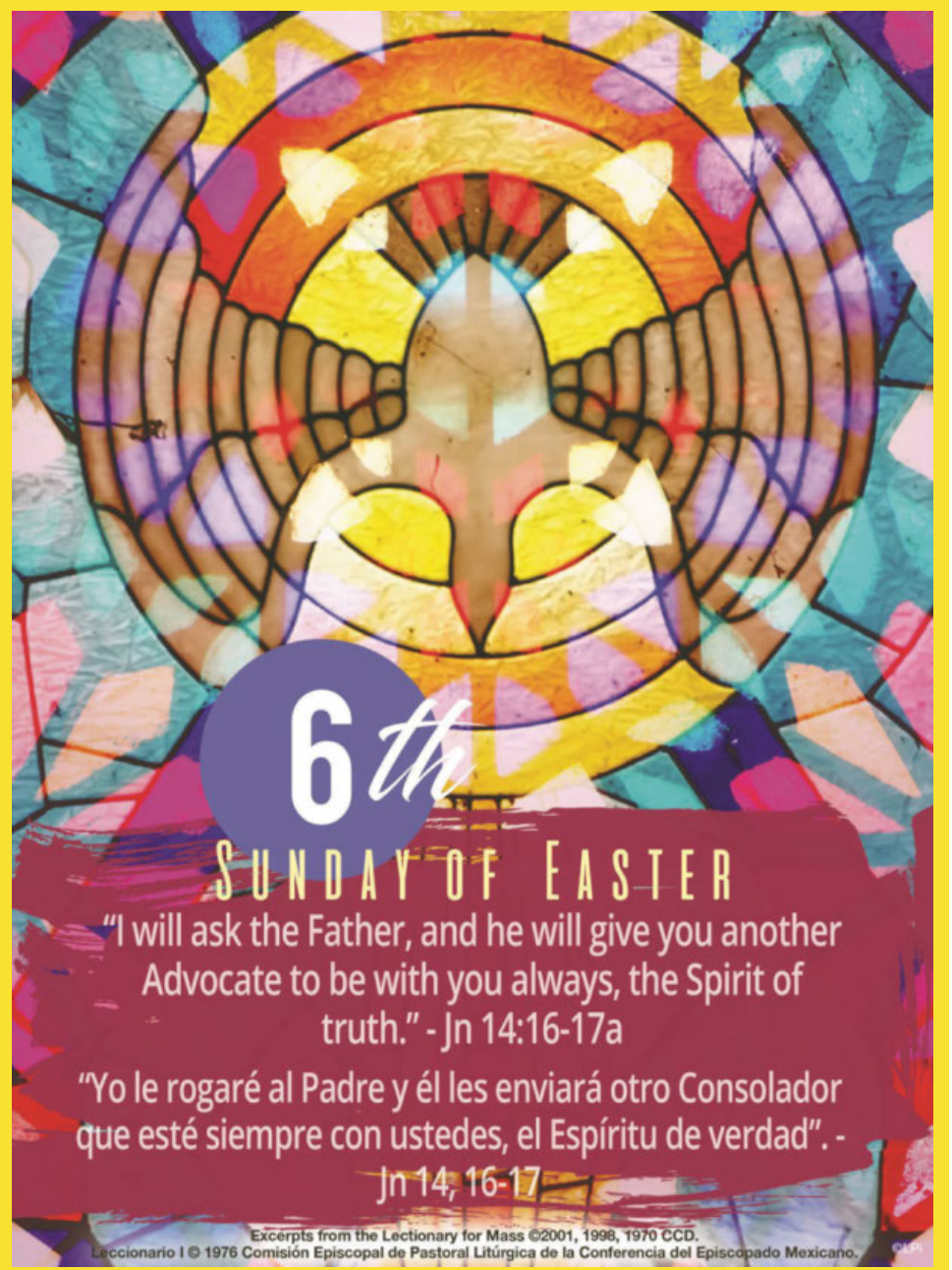

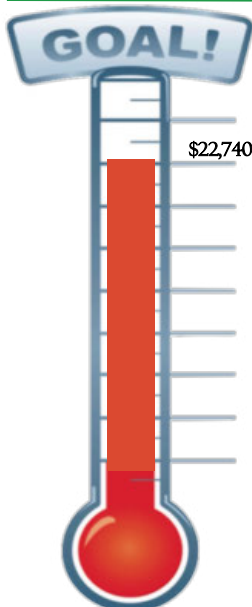

Dear Parish Family,

Blessed and Happy Mother's Day to all of you who have had the blessing to give life to a child of God! What a beautiful gift the Father in heaven has given to those who have the blessing to be called mothers. This gift of motherhood is something literally beyond this world. It is a gift that human beings get to cooperate with the creative power of God. Thank you all for choosing life, and for your willingness to cooperate with the grace of God.

This Sunday's Gospel reminds us that God will not leave us orphans, that God will come to us (Jn 14:15-21). Through the prophet Isaiah, God reminded us that even if a mother would forget her child, God will never forget you (Is 49:15). The Father is always attentive to His children, with tenderness He approaches His beloved children. The gift of motherhood is a reflection of the Father's love for us. By nature, mothers are attentive, caring, loving, self-sacrificial, worry, praying, loving, nurturing among many other things towards their children. Their desire is to keep their children safe, to love them, and to help them grow in life, spiritually, physically, and intellectually. Mothers have the tendency to place their child's needs before their own. Unfortunately, this is not always the case in every home, but the few exceptions are a reflection of our broken humanity.

The beauty of motherhood leads me to reflect on the ancient symbol of Christianity that the early Christians adopted. The ancient legend states that the mother pelican would tear her own breast to feed her children in times of scarcity. The mother would save her children from starvation. Another story says that when her infants were dying, the mother would tear her breast so that her blood would pour over her infants and through her blood they would revive, at the cost of the mother's death. The mother would literally give her life for her children. The legend also says that when pelicans grow, they become pretty aggressive against their mother despite the mother's sacrificial care for them.

This story of the pelican mother reflects the reality of God for His beloved children, you and me. The Father sacrificed His own Son, giving us His flesh and blood to feed us. His blood was poured out for our sake so that we may come alive. God fulfills His promise that He will not leave us orphans, that He will come to our help. At every Mass, this promise is fulfilled. The sacrifice and the love of every mother so beautiful reminds us of the Father's love for His children. There are countless stories where mothers sacrificed their own lives or their goals and desires for the good of their children; mothers who literally chose to die to themselves in order that their children might live. Thank you, mothers, for this beautiful witness that you give us every day of our lives. Thank you for being the reflection of the Father's love for our sake. Through your selflessness and self-sacrificial love, we are reminded that indeed God never forsakes us and always comes to our aid, just like you did when your children were in need or sick. May we ponder this beautiful reality for the rest of our lives. In His Most Sacred Heart,

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

¡Bendito y Feliz Día de la Madre para todas las que han tenido la bendición de dar vida a un hijo de Dios! Que hermoso regalo ha dado el Padre celestial a aquellas que tienen la bendición de ser madres. Este regalo de la maternidad es algo literalmente más allá de este mundo. Es un don que los seres

humanos reciben al cooperar con el poder creador de Dios. Gracias a todos por elegir la vida y por su disposición a cooperar con la gracia de Dios.

El Evangelio de este domingo nos recuerda que Dios no nos dejará huérfanos, que Dios vendrá a nosotros (Jn 14,15-21). A través del profeta Isaías, Dios nos recordó que aunque una madre se olvide de su hijo, Dios nunca se olvidará de ti (Is 49,15). El Padre está siempre atento a sus hijos, con ternura se acerca a nosotros. El don de la maternidad es un reflejo del amor del Padre por nosotros. Por naturaleza, las madres son atentas, cariñosas, amorosas, abnegadas, se preocupan, oran, aman, cuidan, entre muchas otras cosas, a sus hijos. Su deseo es mantener a sus hijos a salvo, amarlos y ayudarlos a crecer en la vida, espiritual, física e intelectualmente. Las madres tienen la tendencia de anteponer las necesidades de sus hijos a las propias. Desafortunadamente, este no es siempre el caso en todos los hogares, pero las pocas excepciones simplemente son un reflejo de nuestra humanidad quebrantada.

La belleza de la maternidad nos lleva a reflexionar sobre el antiguo símbolo del cristianismo que adoptaron los primeros cristianos. La antigua leyenda dice que la madre pelícano se desgarraba el pecho para alimentar a sus hijos en tiempos de escasez. La madre salvaría a sus hijos del hambre. Otra historia dice que cuando sus hijos estaban muriendo, la madre se desgarraba el pecho para que su sangre se derramara sobre sus hijos y a través de su sangre revivieran, a costa de la muerte de la madre. La madre literalmente daría su vida por sus hijos. La leyenda también dice que cuando los pelícanos crecen, se vuelven bastante agresivos con su madre a pesar del cuidado sacrificado de la madre por ellos.

Esta historia de la madre pelícano refleja la realidad de Dios para sus amados hijos, tú y yo. El Padre sacrificó a su propio Hijo, dándonos su carne y sangre para alimentarnos. Su sangre fue derramada por nosotros para que vivamos. Dios cumple su promesa de que no nos dejará huérfanos, que vendrá en nuestra ayuda. En cada Misa, esta promesa se cumple. El sacrificio y el amor de cada madre nos recuerda el amor del Padre por sus hijos. Son innumerables las historias donde las madres sacrificaron su propia vida o sus metas y anhelos por el bien de sus hijos; madres que literalmente eligieron morir a sí mismas para que sus hijos pudieran vivir.

Gracias, mamá, por este hermoso testimonio que nos das cada día de nuestra vida. Gracias por ser el reflejo del amor del Padre por nosotros. A través de su desinterés y amor abnegado, se nos recuerda que, de hecho, Dios nunca nos abandona y siempre viene en nuestra ayuda, tal como lo hiciste cuando sus hijos estaban necesitados o enfermos. Ojalá que podamos reflexionar sobre esta hermosa realidad por el resto de nuestras vidas.

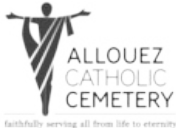

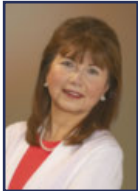

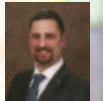
