(Sermon 34.1-3, 5-6; CCL 41, 424-426)



Dear Parish Family,

In this Sunday's Gospel (Mt 13:24-43), Jesus clearly tells us that there is an enemy, the devil himself, who sows weeds in the midst of the Lord's field. Instead of going in and removing the weeds, God waits for both to grow, and then, at the end, He'll separate the weed from the wheat. God could just go and remove the bad. Out of love for the good – the wheat – He waits. Perhaps the enemy thinks he has ruined the joy of the Lord by planting garbage in the Lord's field along with good and beautiful seeds. But out of love the Father waits. Love burns even more in the heart of the Father to give it time so that the wheat can grow and survive; then He'll take care of the problem.

In the First Reading, from the book of wisdom (12:13,16-19), we are reminded that God has the care for all! The Lord is merciful to all, He judges with clemency! The Lord permits repentance for our sins. Out of love, the Father gives us time to repent, to experience the mercy of God as we repent and return to Him. The Father judges! Yes, we will be judged – but with clemency. Compassion, mercy, and forgiveness will be poured upon those who repent and return.

The Father's love is clearly at full display in today's readings. God could just go and eradicate the bad that the devil has planted in the world. But out of love for the good, the Father waits, and He is merciful and patient! He is giving us time to ponder and reflect on His love so that we may return. There are many bad things happening in our world today. Our families and youth are in danger of being contaminated by our secular society. God knows this. God is not afraid. God is mercifully giving us time to repent. As we see the bad all over the place, we can see the devil rejoicing because of the challenges that have come upon us. The Father is asking us to focus on Him. Look at the Father in prayer. See His patient heart and compassion. Ponder the great clemency just for you in the Father's heart. Take refuge in Him. Let the love of the Father be poured out to you so that you too may experience that tremendous love.

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

En el Evangelio de este domingo (Mt 13, 24-43), Jesús nos dice claramente que hay un enemigo, el mismo diablo, que siembra cizaña en medio del campo del Señor. En lugar de entrar y quitar la cizaña, Dios espera que ambos crezcan y luego, al final, separará la cizaña del trigo. Dios podría simplemente ir y eliminar lo malo. Por amor al bien – el trigo – Él espera. Quizás el enemigo piensa que ha arruinado el gozo del Señor al sembrar basura en el campo del Señor junto con semillas buenas y hermosas. Pero por amor el Padre espera. El amor arde aún más en el corazón del Padre para darle tiempo para que el trigo crezca y sobreviva; entonces Él se encargará del problema.

En la Primera Lectura, del libro de la sabiduría (12:13,16-19), se nos recuerda que ¡Dios tiene el cuidado de todos! ¡El Señor es misericordioso con todos, juzga con clemencia! El Señor permite el arrepentimiento por nuestros pecados. Por amor, el Padre nos da tiempo para arrepentirnos, para experimentar la misericordia de Dios a medida que nos arrepentimos y volvemos a Él. ¡El Padre juzga! Sí, seremos juzgados, pero con clemencia. La compasión, la misericordia y el perdón se derramarán sobre aquellos que se arrepientan y regresen.

El amor del Padre está claramente en plena exhibición en las lecturas de hoy. Dios podría simplemente erradicar el mal que el diablo ha plantado en el mundo. ¡Pero por amor al bien, el Padre espera, y es misericordioso y paciente! Él nos está dando tiempo para meditar y reflexionar sobre su amor para que podamos regresar. Hay muchas cosas malas que suceden en nuestro mundo hoy. Nuestras familias y jóvenes están en peligro de ser contaminados por nuestra sociedad secular. Dios sabe esto. Dios no tiene miedo. Dios misericordiosamente nos está dando tiempo para arrepentirnos. Mientras vemos lo malo por todas partes, podemos ver al diablo regocijándose por los desafíos que nos han llegado. El Padre nos está pidiendo que nos centramos en Él. Mirar al Padre en oración. 
