



From Fr Bill Hoffman

Word of the week: "Fasting". Refraining from food or drink for religious purposes. Biblically it implied not eating or drinking from morning till evening.

The Catholic church defines fasting as one meal a day, with two additional breaks. Catholics observe a eucharist fast and abstain from food or drink for one hour before receiving Holy Communion. We also fast annually on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday if in good health and between the ages of 21 and 59.

Saint Augustine: "Do you wish your prayer to fly toward God? Make for it two wings: fasting and almsgiving.

Fasting helps us to detach from worldly things not because they are bad but to remind us that God is the source of all gifts.

Catechism of the Catholic Church #2043 "Fasting and abstinence...help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart".

The spirit of our fasting: Fasting, prayer, and almsgiving are ancient spiritual practices that foster humility and charity.

St Peter Chrysologus: When you fast, see the fasting of others. If you want God to know you are hungry know that another is hungry. If you hope for mercy, show mercy. If you look for kindness, show kindness. If you want to receive, aive".

Faith in Action: Use fasting as a way to see more clearly the things you've missed by inattention.



Pastoral Instruction on the use of the prayer to St. Michael the Archangel in the Liturgy



One of the great tragedies of our day is our state of constant busyness. As individuals and families, we are in a never-ending whirlwind of activity. From the moment we wake up in the morning until we prepare for bed at night, we are constantly running from

day. In our efforts to keep up with this race, we often lose sight of God – turning our eyes away from He who is our strength and our peace. While we may be tempted to believe that constant busyness is harmless, and even a normal part of life, we must recognize the effects it is having on our spiritual life - many of us are living in a state of spiritual slumber. In our present day, the Enemy is using our constant state of preoccupation to distract us from the war he is waging against our souls and the souls of those we love. As we carry on in the hustle and bustle of life, the enemy is attacking us as he works to incite chaos through a culture of confusion, doubt, and fear. When we lose sight of God and start to rely on our own abilities and talents, the enemy, Satan, uses the opportunity to tempt us to move further from God and toward sin. Satan is the father of lies. He seeks to kill and destroy all that is good. He lures us with false promises and hopes that never materialize. When we follow him into sin, we are only left with loneliness, alienation and hopelessness. The fruits of sin are all too evident in our world today. Poverty, racism, violence, wars, genocide and so many other social ills are becoming fi xtures in our daily lives, locally and worldwide. As pastors, parents and all baptized Catholics, we have a responsibility to heed St. Paul's call to awake from our slumber (Romans 13: 11) and put on the armor of God (Ephesians 6:12) to stand f i rm in our faith against the attacks of the evil one who is intent on destroying the Christian faith. History of the St. Michael the Archangel Prayer Around the year 1886, Pope Leo XIII had a vision of the spiritual warfare taking place in the time in which he lived. As he was concluding the celebration of the Mass, he was struck by fear at a vision of the demonic attacks to be carried out against God's people. The encounter had such an impact on the Holy Father that he was moved immediately to pen the words to the prayer so many of us have come to love – the St. Michael the Archangel Prayer. The prayer to St. Michael the Archangel is a powerful plea for the Archangel's intercession. As we read in Scripture, we seek the aid of the one who was chosen by God as protector of the Church and victorious warrior against the evil one.

La iglesia católica define el ayuno como una comida al día, con dos "des-ayunos". Los católicos observan un ayuno eucarístico, de una hora sin comer o beber antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. También ayunamos anualmente el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo si gozamos de buena salud y tenemos entre 21 y 59 años.

San Agustín: "¿Deseas a que su oración vuele hacia Dios? Hazle dos alas: el ayunando y dando limosna". Ayunando nos ayuda desprender de las cosas del mundo, no porque sean malas, sino para recordarnos que Dios es la fuente de todo lo bueno. Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica #2043 "Ayuno y abstinencia... nos adquirir dominio sobre nuestros instintos y la libertad de corazón".

El espíritu de nuestro ayuno: El ayunando, la oración y dar limosna son a prácticas espirituales antiguas que fomentan la humildad y caridad.

San Pedro Crisólogo: "Cuando ayunas, mira el ayuno de los demás. Si deseas a que Dios vea tu hambre, debes saber que otro tiene hambre. Si esperas misericordia, muestra misericordia. Si buscas Los invitamos cordialmente a todos a la misa de amabilidad, muéstrala amabilidad. Si quieres recibir, miércoles de Cenizas a las 7:00 pm. da".
