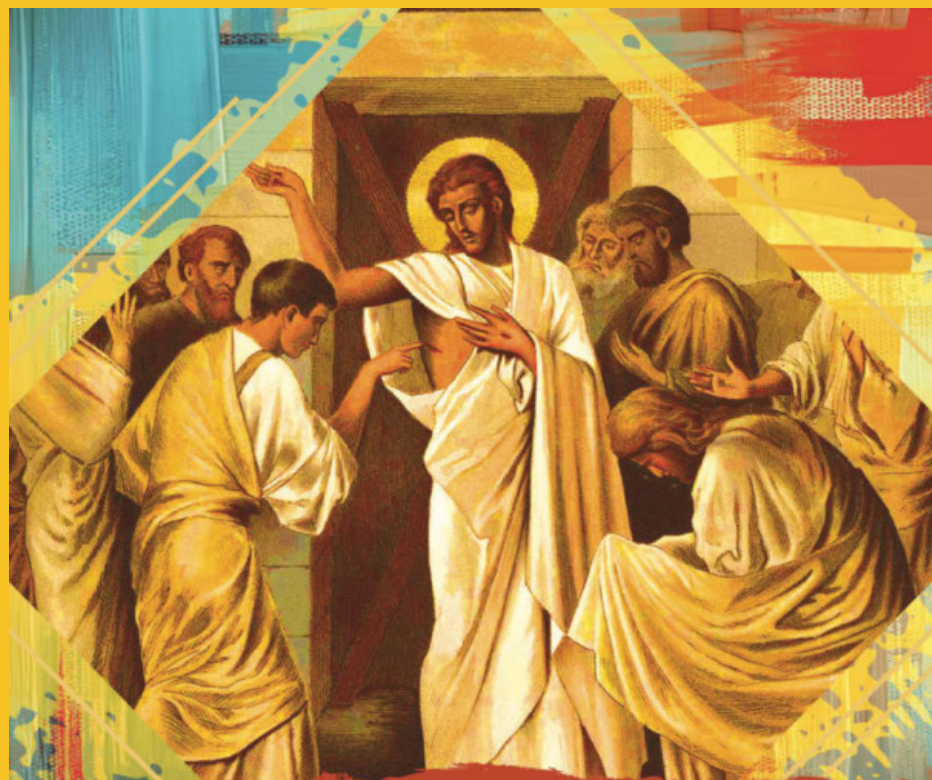

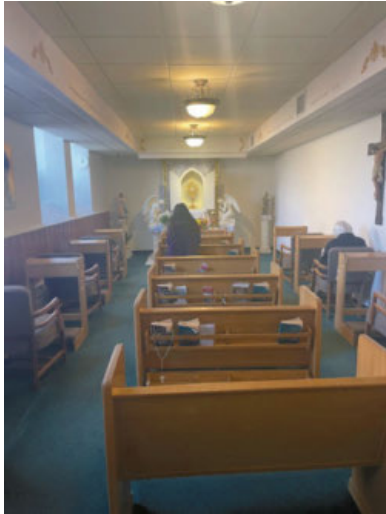

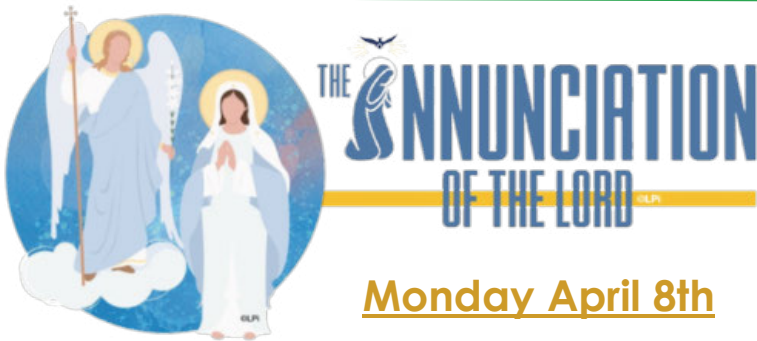

2nd Sunday of Easter



The Gospel today is all about belief and unbelief. God gave us a mind that seems to have room for both. We all can remember occasions like Thomas experienced in that room. We feel overcome with emptiness and absence after we have lost a loved one, or watched a child experience a painful illness, or the time we lost a job that was so desperately needed. In times like these, doubting yourself can be a natural feeling, a natural emotion, but it does not mean you have lost your faith in God, your family, your friends or your fellow man. It does mean that we need to keep our eyes focused on the risen Christ, and in due time, we, like Thomas, will say "My Lord and my God", and we will have joy and hope, and faith and peace again in our life.

Blessed Final Day of the Octave of Easter to You and your Families!

On this 2nd Sunday of Easter we conclude the Octave of Our Lord's Resurrection. This whole week we've

been celebrating Easter with the same solemnity as we did at the Easter Vigil. The Church invites us to feast and celebrate for 8 consecutive days the fact that Our Lord rose victorious over death! Jesus Christ destroyed the kingdom of darkness and we rejoice with the whole Church. God had compassion on the misery and hopelessness of humanity. The darkness that once overwhelmed us, is no longer! Now the power of God has set us free!

The desire of God for us to walk out of our darkness is so incredibly enormous that today He offers us His divine mercy. At the end of the Octave we have the blessing to ponder the Divine Mercy of our Father. Jesus Christ victorious over death now longs to share His divine love so that we too may be victorious over our own darkness. The struggle of our lives can be solved, alleviated, and resolved with God's mercy as He pours Himself out for us.

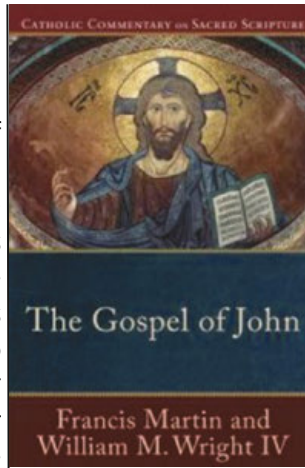
In today's Gospel we are told twice that the disciples locked themselves in even after they saw the Lord (Jn 20:11-18). Their hearts were ruled by the fear and the horror of Jesus' Passion and Death. Fear of that same punishment on them was paralyzing them. Jesus breaks through that fear and offers them His peace.

This reminds me of Niagara Falls. The void in our hearts and the torrents of water reaching down to us is the mercy of the Father who knows that we are dry and in need. The Father provides the abundance of His power to us His beloved children. The mercy of God refreshes the soul, gives life, and changes our hearts from deserts to living forests by His grace.

Today, pray to the Father Almighty that we may experience the grace of His mercy reaching down to our souls with the power and force of His infinite love for each one of us. Just like the waters at Niagara Falls come down with such tremendous force and power, so does the love of God upon those who expect it. Ask for the grace to be open to this incredible love that changes lives and heals our brokenness.

Estimada familia parroquial,
¡Bendito último día de la Octava de Pascua para ustedes y sus familias!
En este segundo domingo de Pascua concluimos la Octava de la Resurrección de Nuestro Señor. Toda esta semana hemos estado celebrando la Pascua con la misma solemnidad que lo hicimos en la Vigilia Pascual. ¡La Iglesia nos invita a festejar y celebrar durante 8 días consecutivos el hecho de que Nuestro Señor resucitó victorioso sobre la muerte! Jesucristo destruyó el reino de las tinieblas y nos regocijamos con toda la Iglesia. Dios tuvo compasión de la miseria y la desesperanza de la humanidad. ¡La oscuridad que una vez nos abrumaba, ya no existe!
¡Ahora el poder de Dios nos ha hecho libres!

El deseo de Dios de que salgamos de nuestra oscuridad es tan enorme que hoy nos ofrece su divina misericordia. 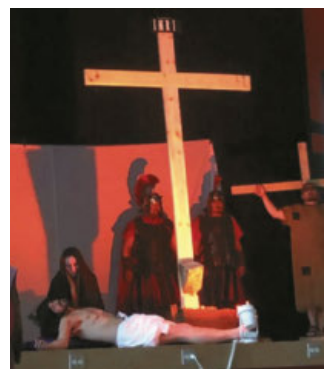
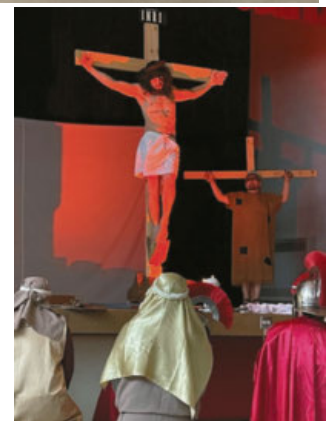


