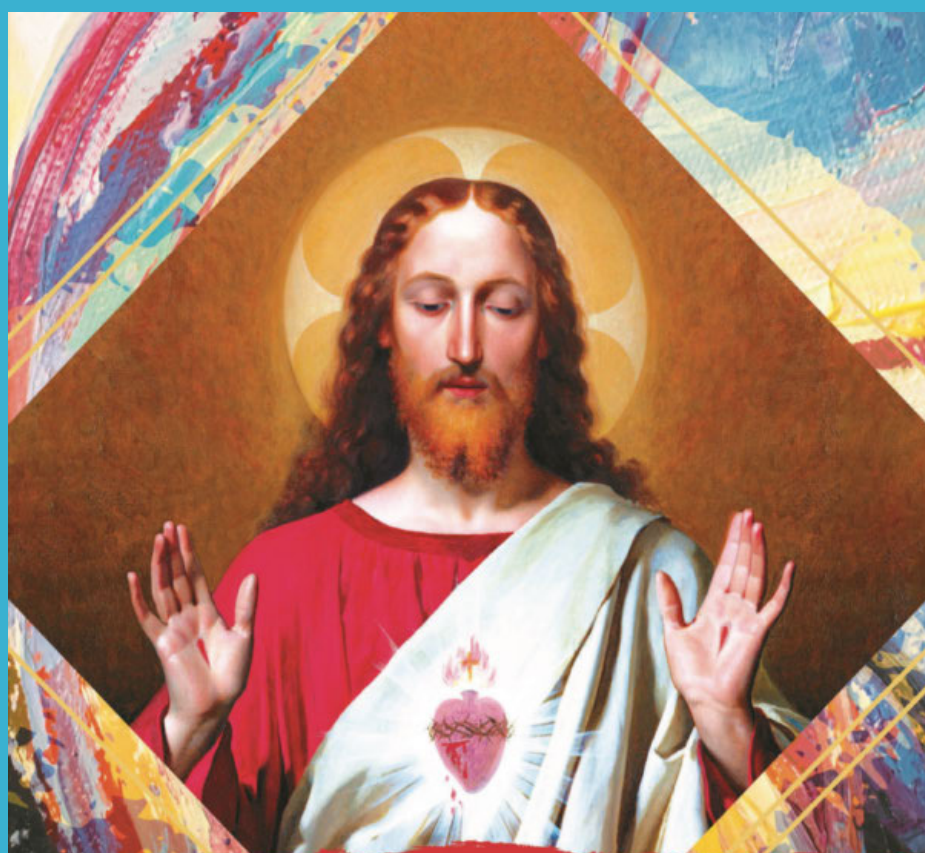

Alleluia!

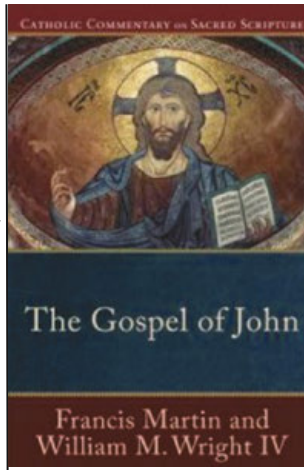
Jesus opened the minds of His disciples after showing them His precious wounds again in today's Gospel (Lk 24:35-48). We hear St. Peter and St. John boldly proclaiming the Gospel and challenging people to repentance and conversion. Jesus continues to work on His disciples as they struggle to believe, as they were "terrified." "Why are you troubled?" asked Jesus. Throughout the readings we notice this development of the relationship between Jesus and His disciples. They are moving from fear, as they were terrified, to intimacy with Jesus as He shows His precious wounds, and then to being formed, molded by Our Lord as He opens their minds. The only reason why they are boldly living their faith and proclaiming the Gospel in the other readings is because they were filled with the peace of Christ; they took refuge in His precious wounds and they let Jesus form them.

This path of the disciples is the same path that we are called to walk with Our Lord. Jesus is also speaking to you and to me. "Why are you troubled?" Jesus' desire to enter into our struggles is evident. He is the first who appears and asks what's going on. Is not our going to Jesus, even the fact that we think about Him, itself a sign that He is thinking of us?

So, Jesus Christ is trying to enter into our lives, to dialogue with His broken children, with us that is. Then once we respond, the Lord wants us to see His wounds. Once we focus on His wounds, we can be healed of our own as we run to Him. The Lord shows His vulnerability as He is willing to show us the mark of His infinity love for us. "Look" Jesus says, as He shows His wounds. It seems like He is almost saying to us, "Look how I love you, come and receive my comfort, my love and healing. Stop looking at your own woundedness and look at Him who is completely fixed on you!" Then once we look at the beauty of the savior we too can let Him form us, shape us, and teach us. This requires vulnerability on our part, just like He is vulnerable with us when He displays His wounds for us. The more we pray, the more we come to visit Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, the more we run to Him as he forms us and opens our minds to see Him and love Him.

Jesus is asking us, "Why are you troubled?" He is begging us to look at Him! He wants to open our hearts and minds. What's your response? Will you look at Him? Will you let Him open your mind? Come and pray, He is waiting for you at Holy Mass and in our Eucharistic Adoration Chapel. Do you know why we are struggling to fill up all the hours at our chapel? Because people do not want to hear Him, do not want to look at Him, do not want Him to open their minds. Will you let Him speak to you? Will you come to look at Him?

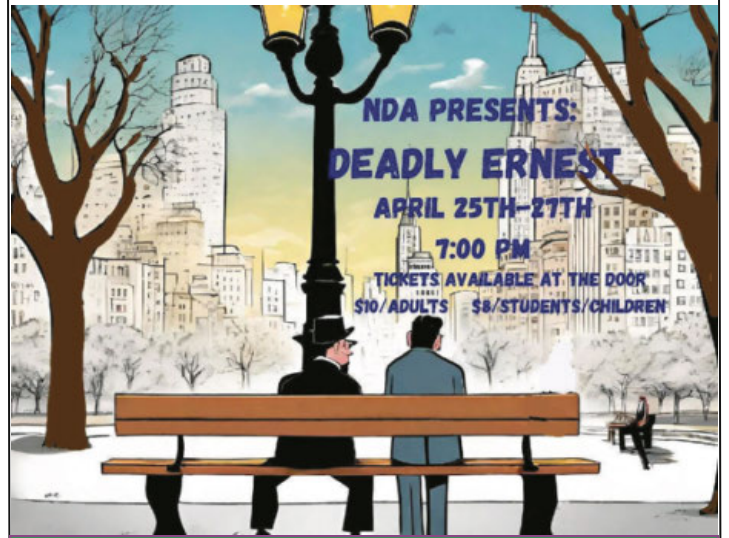

Estimada Familia Parroquial,
¡Alabado sea Jesucristo! ¡El Señor ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya!

Jesús abrió la mente de sus discípulos después de mostrarles nuevamente sus llagas preciosas en el evangelio de hoy (Lc 24,35-48). Escuchamos a San Pedro y a San Juan proclamar con valentía el Evangelio y desafiar a la gente al arrepentimiento y la conversión. Jesús continúa obrando en sus discípulos mientras luchan por creer, ya que estaban "aterrorizados". "¿Por qué se espantan?" preguntó Jesús. A lo largo de las lecturas notamos este desarrollo de la relación entre Jesús y sus discípulos. Están pasando del miedo, cuando estaban aterrorizados, a la intimidad con Jesús mientras Él muestra Sus llagas, y luego a ser formados, moldeados por Nuestro Señor cuando Él abre sus mentes. La única razón por la que viven con valentía su fe y proclaman el Evangelio en las otras lecturas es porque estaban llenos de la paz de Cristo; se refugiaron en sus preciosas llagas y dejaron que Jesús las formara.

Este camino de los discípulos es el mismo camino que estamos llamados a recorrer con Nuestro Señor. Jesús también nos está hablando a ti y a mí. "¿Por qué estás preocupado?" Es evidente el deseo de Jesús de entrar en nuestras luchas. Es el primero que aparece y pregunta qué pasa. ¿Acaso nuestro ir a Jesús, incluso el hecho de que pensemos en Él, no es en sí mismo una señal de que Él está pensando en nosotros?

Entonces, Jesucristo está tratando de entrar en nuestras vidas, de dialogar con Sus hijos quebrantados, es decir, con nosotros. Luego, una vez que respondemos, el Señor quiere que veamos Sus heridas. Una vez que nos concentramos en Sus heridas, podemos ser sanados mientras corremos hacia Él. El Señor muestra Su vulnerabilidad ya que está dispuesto a mostrarnos la marca de Su infinito amor por nosotros. "Miren", dice Jesús, mientras muestra sus llagas. Parece que casi nos está diciendo: "Mira cómo te amo, ven y recibe mi consuelo, mi amor y sanación. ¡Deja de mirar tu propia herida y mira a Aquel que está completamente fijo en ti! Entonces, una vez que miramos la belleza del Salvador, nosotros también podemos dejar que Él nos forme, nos moldee y nos enseñe. Esto requiere vulnerabilidad de nuestra parte, así como Él es vulnerable con nosotros cuando muestra Sus heridas por nosotros. Cuanto más oramos, más visitamos a Nuestro Señor Sacramentado, más corremos hacia Él mientras nos forma y abre nuestra mente para verlo y amarlo.

Jesús nos pregunta: "¿Por qué están preocupados?" ¡Él nos está rogando que lo miremos! Él quiere abrir nuestros corazones y nuestras mentes. ¿Cuál es tu respuesta? ¿Lo mirarás? ¿Permitirás que Él abra tu mente? Vengan a orar, Él nos espera en la Santa Misa y en nuestra Capilla de Adoración Eucarística. ¿Sabes por qué nos cuesta llenar todas las horas en nuestra capilla? Porque la gente no quiere escucharlo, no quiere mirarlo, no quiere que Él les abra la mente. ¿Dejarás que Él te hable? ¿Vendrás a mirarlo?


