Dear Parish Family,

God is love and it is not that we love Him but that He has loved us first, as St. John tells us in our Second Reading today (1 Jn 4: 7-10). We often use the word love to point out the things we like or the people that we truly care about. As I walk with married couples, I often ask if they remember the day when they held, for the very first time, their first child (or any of their children for that matter). Most all describe the moment, the tears, the overwhelming sense of love that they feel for this little child! We do not know where this feeling of love comes from, but those who are parents – or if you have fallen in love – you know that it is real and powerful.

There is a certain power to love. Love has the power to give life, joy, hope and it helps us understand the great capacity that we have not only to love but also to sacrifice for the ones we love. The great ability that we have to endure challenges and difficulties for the people we dearly care about. All of this beauty comes from the fact that it is God Himself who loves us, who pours His love upon us so that we can love and experience the power of life, joy, hope, and many other blessings. Everything about love is beautiful because it is God Himself Whom we receive, Who gives us life, Who allows us to endure and sacrifice for the ones we love.

Jesus tells us that we are loved by Him just like He is loved by the Father (Jn 15: 9-17). it is a love that we don't even understand but we long for. It is the love that allows us to be alive because we are chosen and deeply loved by God. It is a love that has led our Savior to the Cross but the love of the Father brought Him back alive. This is the power of the love of God. It can bring us from death to life, from dark and lonely places to light and love. This is the God Who is pursuing your heart, the Father who is fully committed to you because you are the crown jewel of His creation. Pray hard about how the Father loves Jesus, because it is with that same powerful force that you too are loved by Him.

KIDS Corner





Estimada Familia Parroquial,

Dios es amor y no es que nosotros le amemos sino que Él nos ha amado primero, como nos dice San Juan en nuestra Segunda Lectura de hoy (1 Jn 4, 7-10). A menudo utilizamos la palabra amor para señalar las cosas que nos gustan o las personas que realmente nos importan. Cuando camino con parejas casadas, a menudo les pregunto si recuerdan el día en que tuvieron, por primera vez, a su primer hijo (o a cualquiera de sus hijos). ¡La mayoría describe el momento, las lágrimas, el sentimiento abrumador de amor que sienten por este pequeño bebe! No sabemos de dónde viene este sentimiento de amor, pero quienes son padres -o si nos hemos enamorado- sabemos que es real y poderoso.

Hay un cierto poder en amar. El amor tiene el poder de dar vida, alegría, esperanza y nos ayuda a comprender la gran capacidad que tenemos no sólo de amar sino también de sacrificarnos por quienes amamos. La gran capacidad que tenemos para soportar desafíos y dificultades por las personas que tanto queremos. Toda esta belleza proviene del hecho de que es Dios mismo quien nos ama, quien derrama Su amor sobre nosotros para que podamos amar y experimentar el poder de la vida, el gozo, la esperanza y muchas otras bendiciones. Todo lo relacionado con el amor es hermoso porque es Dios mismo a quien recibimos, quien nos da vida, quien nos permite perseverar y sacrificarnos por quienes amamos.

Jesús nos dice que somos amados por Él como él es amado por el Padre (Jn 15, 9-17). Es un amor que ni siquiera entendemos pero que anhelamos. Es el amor que nos permite estar vivos porque somos elegidos y amados profundamente por Dios. Es un amor que llevó a nuestro Salvador a la Cruz pero el amor del Padre lo trajo de regreso con vida. Este es el poder del amor de Dios. Puede llevarnos de la muerte a la vida, de lugares oscuros y solitarios a la luz y el amor. Este es el Dios que busca tu corazón, el Padre que está completamente comprometido contigo porque eres la joya de la corona de Su creación. Oremos mucho sobre cómo el Padre ama a Jesús, porque es con esa misma fuerza poderosa con la que nosotros también somos amados por Él.

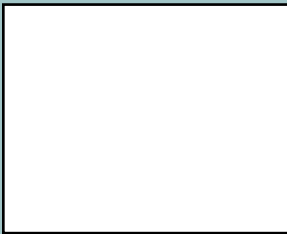
