Dear Parish Family,

Blessed Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord into heaven!

The doors of heaven are thrown open for us now as Our Lord Jesus Christ enters into heaven so He brings our humanity with Him. Jesus ascends

in Body and Spirit. His human Body is right there next to the Father. The presence of His body in heaven reminds us that where the head has gone, so the body follows. It is God's desire to lead all of His children back home to where we really belong, in union with the Father. Literally right next to Him, worshiping the Father for eternity, filled with the joy of His love.

This solemnity can be a bit abstract, but there is something so real about it when a loved one dies. All of the sudden you do realize that we hope for them to be in heaven and it is only possible because Jesus Christ has thrown open the doors of heaven for us and our loved ones. When my own father passed away, as I anointed him, prayed with him and literally cried with my family, at the funeral Mass the realization of the importance of this solemnity came to mind. Dad has the potential to go to heaven simply because the path was made by Our Lord as He literally opened up the doors for all of us to follow. There is an "open door" policy in heaven. God is looking forward to receiving our bodies and souls in heaven, ready for the intimate and everlasting union with Him.

Every time we enter into Holy Mass as we walk through the doors of the Church, it becomes like a foreshadow of what awaits us in heaven. What awaits is the worship of the Father, the deep and intimate union with the Lord, the encounter with our creator and Father. Every time we enter into Mass we are encountered, loved, helped, healed, and strengthened by the Father. We don't go to Church to do a favor to God, but God favors us as we approach Him. As you come to encounter God at Mass, bring your family and friends. Tell others about the beauty of the Father who loves you and strengthens you as we worship Him. The reality of heaven begins here on earth at every Mass. Come and worship the Father, bring others to Him, literally throw them into the arms of the Father!

Estimada Familia Parroquial,  
¡Bendita Solemnidad de la Ascensión de Nuestro Señor al cielo!

Papá tiene el potencial de ir al cielo simplemente porque nuestro Señor abrió el camino cuando literalmente abrió las puertas para que todos lo sigamos. Hay una política de "puerta abierta" en el cielo. Dios espera recibir nuestros cuerpos y almas en el cielo, listos para la unión íntima y eterna con Él.

Cada vez que entramos en la Santa Misa al cruzar las puertas de la Iglesia, se convierte en una antesala de lo que nos espera en el cielo. Lo que espera es la adoración al Padre, la unión profunda e íntima con el Señor, el encuentro con nuestro creador y Padre. Cada vez que entramos a Misa somos encontrados, amados, ayudados, sanados y fortalecidos por el Padre. No vamos a la Iglesia para hacerle un favor a Dios, pero Dios nos favorece cuando nos acercamos a Él. Cuando te encuentres con Dios en la Misa, trae a tu familia y amigos. Cuéntale a otros sobre la belleza del Padre que te ama y te fortalece mientras lo adoramos. La realidad del cielo comienza aquí en la tierra en cada Misa. ¡Ven y adora al Padre, trae a otros a Él, literalmente avientaselos a los brazos del Padre!




