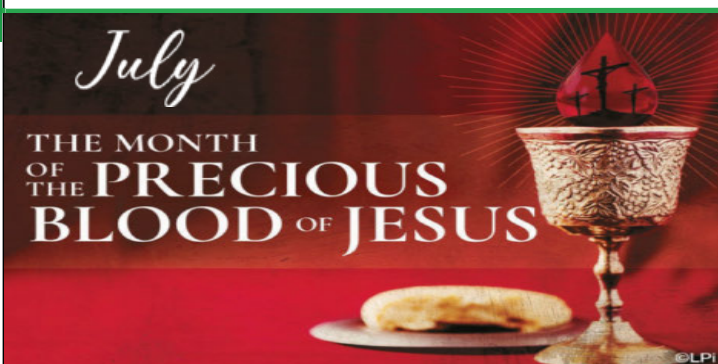

Dear Parish Family,
 Blessed belated 4th of July - Independence Day - to you all! We just celebrated freedom and independence as a nation. Our Lord desires to give us freedom from sin and grace every day of our lives. What we just celebrated as a nation, is what the Father in heaven offers us, His children: True independence from the world of darkness, vice, and sin, so that we can live in the freedom and joy that God has to offer. Blessed be God!

This Sunday, we hear in the Gospel that Jesus is amazed and not precisely for a good thing, but amazed at the lack of faith from the people (Mk 6:6). Jesus is surprised to see that people do not believe and don't trust Him. Pray with this image of Jesus being amazed. Do some Lectio Divina, ask the Holy Spirit to guide you to contemplate this beautiful but also sad reality. Our Lord looks at His own people, what does His gaze look like? What are His facial expressions as He looks at them with love and desires to unleash His power to heal and liberate the sick and the oppressed? There is this clash between Jesus' love and desire to heal His chosen people, and this lack of faith, trust, and willingness to receive His love.

There is a power in Jesus' love that sets the human heart free from self-condemnation, corruption, messiness, and the cruelty of demons devouring our weak flesh. When the human soul is able to receive this love it changes lives! This is the freedom that the Father desires for His children. Through St. Paul we are reminded today that this love of God doesn't necessarily mean a problem-free life (2 Cor 12:7-10). Challenges, obstacles, and even demons will be there poking our hearts trying to destroy us, but the love of God will give us strength to persevere, to be humble, and to let the Father help us. This was the reality for St. Paul, one of our patron saints! So, it is with us as well. Problems, difficulties, and thorns in our flesh will always be there, but God will be there as well. His love will carry us forward. In our weaknesses, God displays His power as Saint Paul reminds us, "for when I am weak, then I am strong" (2 Cor 12:10).

Dear friends, unfortunately we often behave like the chosen people with no faith. We often try to rationalize everything and try to come up with our own solutions.. Just like Jesus looked at those individuals, so He looks at us. What is Our Lord's gaze like? How do we meet His desperate desire to love and heal in our lives? When Our Lord looks at you, is He pleasantly surprised or quite the opposite? May we let Him love us in our weaknesses, and let His love shine through our poverty.

Estimada Familia Parroquial,
¡Bendecido 4 de julio, Día de la Independencia, para todos ustedes! Acabamos de celebrar la libertad y la independencia como nación. Nuestro Señor desea darnos libertad del pecado y gracia todos los días de nuestras vidas. Lo

que acabamos de celebrar como nación, es lo que el Padre celestial nos ofrece a nosotros, sus hijos: verdadera independencia del mundo de oscuridad, vicio y pecado, para que podamos vivir en la libertad y el gozo que Dios tiene para ofrecer. ¡Bendito sea Dios!

Este domingo escuchamos en el Evangelio que Jesús está asombrado y no precisamente por algo bueno, sino por la falta de fe de la gente (Mc 6,6). Jesús se sorprende al ver que la gente no cree y no confía en Él. Ora y medita con esta imagen de Jesús asombrado. Haz algo de Lectio Divina, pide al Espíritu Santo que te guíe para contemplar esta hermosa pero también triste realidad. Nuestro Señor mira a su propio pueblo, ¿cómo es su mirada? ¿Cuáles son sus expresiones cuando los mira con amor y desea desatar su poder para sanar y liberar a los enfermos y oprimidos? Existe este choque entre el amor y el deseo de Jesús de sanar a su pueblo y esta falta de fe, confianza y voluntad de recibir su amor.

Hay un poder en el amor de Jesús que libera el corazón humano de la autocondena, la corrupción, el desorden y la crueldad de los demonios que devoran nuestra carne débil. ¡Cuando el alma humana es capaz de recibir este amor cambia vidas! Ésta es la libertad que el Padre desea para Sus hijos. A través de San Pablo se nos recuerda hoy que este amor de Dios no significa necesariamente una vida libre de problemas (2 Cor 12:7-10). Retos, obstáculos y hasta demonios estarán ahí mordiendo nuestro corazón tratando de destruirnos, pero el amor de Dios nos dará fuerzas para perseverar, ser humildes y dejar que el Padre nos ayude. ¡Esta fue la realidad para San Pablo, uno de nuestros santos patronos! Así es también con nosotros. Los problemas, las dificultades y las espinas en nuestra carne siempre estarán ahí, pero Dios también estará ahí. Su amor nos hará avanzar. En nuestras debilidades, Dios muestra su poder como nos recuerda San Pablo, "porque cuando soy débil, entonces soy fuerte" (2 Cor 12:10).

Queridos amigos, lamentablemente a menudo nos comportamos como el pueblo elegido y sin fe. A menudo tratamos de racionalizar todo y tratamos de encontrar nuestras propias soluciones. Así como Jesús miró a esos individuos, así nos mira a nosotros. ¿Cómo es la mirada de Nuestro Señor? ¿Cómo podemos satisfacer su deseo desesperado de amar y sanar en nuestras vidas? Cuando Nuestro Señor nos mira, ¿se sorprende gratamente o todo lo contrario? Dejemos que Él nos ame en nuestras debilidades y que su amor brille a través de nuestra pobreza.

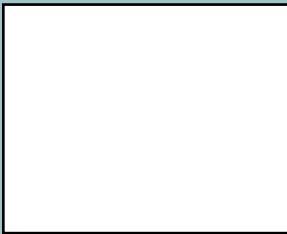
