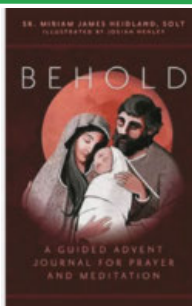
Greeting Men,

Dear Parish Family,

September 29th is the Feast of the Archangels, mostly known as the feast of St. Michael the Archangel. This year, September 29th is a Sunday, therefore we don't celebrate the feast of the archangels liturgically because the Sunday obligation trumps the feast of the day. Though we'll not be able to celebrate the feast day this year, it is worthwhile pondering the role of the archangels, specifically the role of St. Michael.

St. Michael is the prince of the heavenly host, dedicated to the protection of the human race from the snares of the devil. It is God's gift to us so that we can have a defender against the snares of the enemy. God alone could have done the job, in fact we know that from the moment of our Baptism by the power of the Holy Spirit, God Himself walks with us wherever we go. But God wants to give us advocates and defenders to protect us on the way. Such is the beauty of the Father's love for each one of His children.

The typical depiction of St. Michael shows him crushing Satan's head. A clear image that displays St. Michael's mission entrusted to him by the Father, to protect God's children. The spiritual warfare is true and real. Just like there is a God who loves His children, there is the prince of the kingdom of darkness who despises us because the Father loves us. Sin is the trap of the devil to pull us away from the Father. The devil hides the misery of hell with a false sense of sweetness and pleasure in sin. Here it is where the beauty of the archangel's protection comes into play. The Father knows the lies of the devil and sends St. Michael to defend us in battle.

We can't leave all the battles to St. Michael. We must strive to be faithful and obedient to God in His Church. The more we pray, worship the Lord at Mass, receive Holy Communion, and go frequently to Confession, the closer we stay to God. The more we focus on Him and not on us, the humbler we become and the more fulfilled and satisfied our souls become.

The Father in heaven desires to protect His beloved children. We must be willing to let Him protect us with His host of the heavenly army!

Part One. "Nothing is impossible with God"

On July 1st, 1993, Msgr. Roy Klister arrived at Saints Peter and Paul as a pastor. Within a week of his arrival, a small group of faithful parishioners asked, "Could we have Perpetual Adoration here?" Msgr. Klister said that he wouldn't have known what his answer would have been if it wasn't for his time spent at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD where he experienced a deep appreciation of Eucharistic Devotion. There he discovered that the dioceses in which there was regular Eucharistic devotion and adoration were the ones with the largest callings for the priesthood and the quality of the candidates were especially impressive. Msgr. Klister didn't need to be convinced of the value of promoting adoration of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. *To be continued...*

Querida Familia Parroquial,

El 29 de septiembre es la Fiesta de los Arcángeles, más conocida como la fiesta de San Miguel Arcángel. Este año, el 29 de septiembre es domingo, por lo tanto no celebramos litúrgicamente la fiesta de los arcángeles porque la obligación del domingo prevalece sobre la fiesta del día. Aunque este año no podremos celebrar la fiesta, vale la pena reflexionar sobre el papel de los arcángeles, específicamente el papel de San Miguel.

San Miguel es el príncipe de la milicia celestial, dedicado a la protección de la raza humana de las trampas del diablo. Es el regalo de Dios para nosotros para que podamos tener un defensor contra las trampas del enemigo. La representación típica de San Miguel lo muestra aplastando la cabeza de Satanás. Una imagen clara que muestra la misión de San Miguel que le encomendó el Padre: proteger a sus hijos. La guerra espiritual es real. Así como hay un Dios que ama a Sus hijos, existe el príncipe de las tinieblas que nos desprecia porque el Padre nos ama. El pecado es la trampa del diablo para alejarnos del Padre. El diablo oculta la miseria del infierno con una falsa sensación de dulzura y placer en el pecado. Aquí es donde entra en juego la belleza de la protección del arcángel. El Padre conoce las mentiras del diablo y envía a San Miguel para defendernos en la batalla.

No podemos dejarle todas las batallas a San Miguel. Debemos esforzarnos por ser fieles y obedientes a Dios en Su Iglesia.
