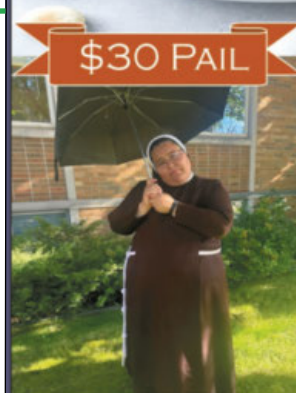

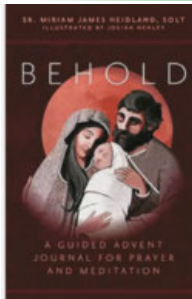
Greeting Men,

Dear Parish Family,
 "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a suitable partner for him..." (Gen 2:18-24).

The Father in heaven has compassion regarding the loneliness of His children. The Father longs for us to be in solitude with Him, but the Lord knows that there is a need in our hearts to share the beauty of His love with someone like us, capable of receiving love! The Father knew that nothing from the created world would be a suitable partner for the man, except someone like him. "This one, at last, is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh..." (Gen 2:23-24). From within the heart of the man comes this profound cry of joy when he sees a beloved spouse.

Nothing was good enough for Adam in the garden until his beloved spouse was created. Finally someone like him with the capacity to love and be loved! Someone who could receive the true love that the Father was placing in his heart. This deep loud cry of joy from the heart of the man, was a reflection of the reality that the man could see and find himself in the beauty of the woman. Adam could see the beauty of her dignity, the perfection with which God had made them. They could see the complementarity of their bodies and souls. They could finally enter into a deep communion with someone whom they loved and loved them. What a marvelous reality, what a profound invitation from God to discover Him, in the depths of the profound beauty of marriage.

Given the beauty of marriage that God intends for His children, this is why Jesus says that divorce is not lawful. By definition divorce is a separation of the intimate union that God intends for the couple and the family. It is not good for man (humanity) to be alone. Human brokenness is undeniable, but also the grace that God gives a couple when they truly seek the Lord. There are many reasons why marriages fail. One of them is definitely not because their spouses loved the Lord too much. When both are focused on God and both strive to grow in their relationship with the Lord, naturally they'll become selfless, joyful, generous, sacrificial towards their love and attitude for one another. Failure in marriage happens often when one or both don't take God seriously, don't pray everyday, don't offer themselves as a sacrifice for the good of their spouse and family. The Father desires the good of the marriage, the salvation of their souls, and this will not come in comfort or a pleasurable life. Every success in life comes with hard work, so it is our union with the Lord in prayer. Yes, growth in the spiritual life also comes with hard work.

Turn to the Lord in prayer, seek the face of God and He will reveal Himself in your spouse and your family. For those who don't have a spouse or family, the Lord reveals Himself in true friends who love the Lord and love us because of their love for the Lord. The Lord desires a deep and intimate union with you, seek Him and ask Him to teach you how to love like you are loved by Him.

Part One. "Nothing is impossible with God"

It was charged with the enthusiasm of the small group from SSPP, Msgr. Blister approached the then Most Reverend Bishop Joseph Banks for permission to begin establishing a chapel. The Bishop had reservations about whether it was possible to meet security requirements and find the people to fill up the hourly time slots. He was also concerned there would be more emphasis put on Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament than on the Mass. All this led to a delay of permission.

In 1994, a year later, the Bishop was approached again by Monsignor and the small group with assurances that those who did adoration were those who attended Mass most regularly. But the Bishop was still concerned about security. And again, they departed with no permission. *To be continued...*

3. On the following three small beads, pray three Hail Marys.
4. On the chain, pray the Glory Be.
5. On the large bead, meditate on the first mystery and pray the Our Father.
6. Pray a Hail Mary on each of the 10 smaller beads.
7. On the chain, pray the Glory Be & the Fatima Prayer.
8. Repeat each decade starting with the Our Father until you reach the medal in the center.
9. Repeat each decade starting with the Our Father until you reach the medal in the center.
10. Finish by praying the Hail, Holy Queen and closing prayer.
