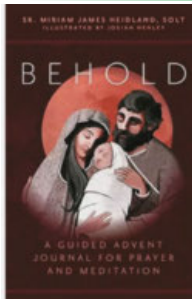

Dear Parish Family,

This week all of us priests and pastoral leaders were gathered with the bishop and we are grateful for your prayers. It is a beautiful time to gather with our bishop as he speaks to us about the direction in which he desires to take

our diocese, which is to lead us closer to Jesus Christ. Please continue to pray for us that we may be attentive to the voice of the Holy Spirit.

"Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" is the question that the man in the Gospel is asking Our Lord (Mk 10:17-30). The man is interested in getting into heaven and is genuinely trying as he has been faithful to God's commandments. The Lord had blessed him greatly on this earth with many possessions. The unfortunate reality was that this man was so attached to his earthly treasures that he was willing to let go of the eternal treasure to embrace his earthly treasure. It seems that this man exchanged the eternal for the earthly.

Imagine the tremendous sadness in this man's face. He is looking at Jesus and all of the sudden he hears that he has to share with the poor what he has, his "face fell, and he went away sad..." He stopped looking at Jesus as he "embraced" his possessions. There was an incredible amount of sadness at Jesus' invitation. So much sadness that his face dropped. Enter into this Gospel passage and receive the loving gaze of Jesus along with His own invitation to you. Our Lord is always inviting us to be part of the mission of saving souls, ask Him directly what is it that you and I are lacking so that we may inherit eternal life. Be prepared to be radically generous with the Lord. May we ask for the courage to respond to His invitation.

Our bishop's goal is to lead us to Jesus, to encounter the beauty of His mercy so that we may share that love with others. At the parish, every activity is focused on Jesus Christ so that we may encounter His person, love, and mercy. He desires to look at us and us to look at Him. There is an invitation from the Lord Himself for us to follow Him, would you look at Him in prayer? Would you be willing to do what He asks, not just what you want to do?

Not only did Bishop Banks reply positively but asked that prayers for vocations be a regular intention of our adorers.

At this time, Sharon Van Ooyen stepped up to take the position of coordinator. With answers to many prayers, a dedicated planning team was founded. They proceeded to dig in their heels and heads to create the start of the Christ the King Adoration Chapel that was established at SSPP church.

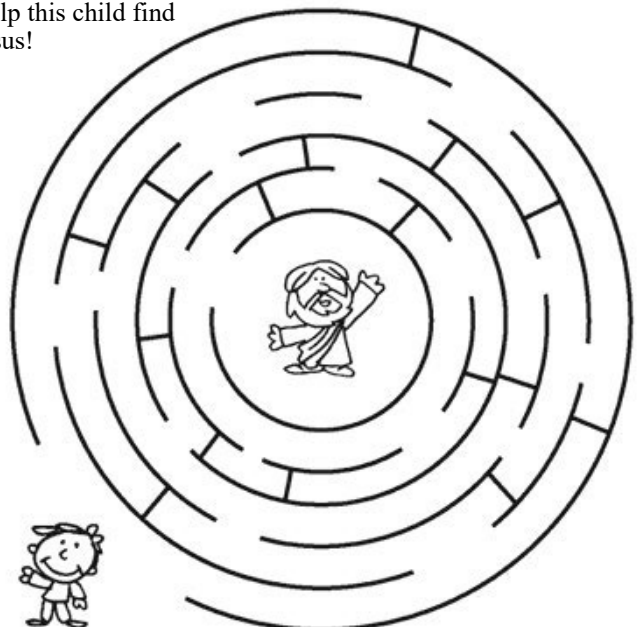
**HISTORIA DE LA CAPILLA DE




