Dear Parish Family,

This past week our parish staff and some of our pastoral and financial council members, went on a retreat to be with the Lord. It may sound strange to some of us, but why do we need to pull away and be with Jesus when in theory we work with Him & for Him here in our parish. It is easy to do your work or duties out of a routine mechanism rather than out of love and zeal for the Lord. By pulling away on retreat to be with the Lord in a very intentional way, it allows us the opportunity to sit with the Lord, at His feet and contemplate His presence. Prayer is not necessarily about "doing", but about "being" with the Lord. Contemplation is being in His presence and "wasting" (spending) time looking at Him. Surrendering and seriously seeking holiness was the path on which Our Lord took our team. Honestly, it was not the direction I was planning on, but it was where the Lord wanted to take us. As we went through the time of prayer, meditation, reflection, and sharing, it was clear that it was what we needed. It is God asking us to surrender to His majesty and begin to seriously and actively pursue holiness. Certainly, this was a beautiful wake-up call from our Lord to me as His priest. We know we need to be holy and seek the Lord with all our hearts, but if we are honest with ourselves, how much time do we actually dedicate daily towards this goal, as most of us are buried with responsibilities, projects, family, work, and many other anxieties that fill our hearts?

This Sunday we are reminded of the end times; the end of the world as we know it and the final coming of Jesus Christ. The Gospel reminds us about the darkness and the fall of the stars from the sky (Mk 13:24-32), certainly imagery that can lead to fear especially as we are told that the powers in heaven will be shaken! During that darkness, we are told about the glory, the great power, and the heavenly host accompanying the majesty of Jesus Christ. In the darkness, the glory of God will shine. The power of Jesus Christ will break through the most profound darkness. This is where the importance of contemplative prayer and intimate dialogue with Jesus comes into play.

This glory and power of God breaking through the darkness is not only happening at the end of the world. When we pray, as we spend time with Our Lord in silence – accompanying Him in solitude – the power of God breaks through the struggles, sufferings, and challenges of our lives. The glory of God is met by our need as we actively search for the glory of Jesus Christ. The more we search, pray, and pull away from our busy lives to be with Jesus Christ, the more we come to know and experience the glory, the power, and the majesty of God. As we contemplate and search for Him in prayer, we'll come in contact with the same Jesus who is coming at the end of the world. We can know, experience, and love our Savior as we let ourselves be known by Him in prayer – as we become vulnerable and share our lives with Him. Then we experience His presence, His face and heart, loving, sustaining, healing, and embracing us in our own darkness. Do not be afraid of the end of the world; be more afraid of missing the opportunity to experience His presence, glory, and love every day by not coming to Him in silence. There is no holiness without prayer. There is no heaven without coming to Jesus Christ in silent mental prayer.

Con el paso de los años, el P. Farrell había sido testigo de cómo la asistencia a la capilla aumentaba hasta su capacidad. La parroquia decidió para trasladarse a un espacio más grande en la esquina noroeste del nivel inferior. El 22 de mayo de 2005, después de mucho trabajo

y necesitaba oraciones, la Capilla de Cristo Rey fue rededicada. El P. Y con la sorprendente Gracia de Dios el Señor puede seguir haciéndonos instrumentos de Su gracia porque, como todos sabemos, ¡NADA ES IMPOSIBLE PARA DIOS!

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

Esta semana pasada, nuestro personal parroquial y algunos miembros de nuestros consejos pastoral y financiero, fuimos de retiro para estar con el Señor. Puede sonar extraño, por qué necesitamos apartarnos y estar con Jesús cuando, en teoría, trabajamos con Él y para Él aquí en la parroquia. Es muy fácil hacer nuestro trabajo o deberes por rutina mecánica en lugar de por amor y celo por el Señor. Al apartarnos en retiro para estar con el Señor de manera muy intencional, nos permite la oportunidad de sentarnos con el Señor, a Sus pies y contemplar Su presencia. La oración no se trata necesariamente de "hacer", sino de "estar" con el Señor. La contemplación es estar en Su presencia y "perder" (gastar) tiempo mirándolo.

El rendirnos y la búsqueda seria de la santidad fue el camino por el cual Nuestro Señor llevó a nuestro equipo. Honestamente, no era la dirección que yo estaba planeando, pero era donde el Señor quería llevarnos. A medida que pasamos tiempo en oración, meditación, reflexión y compartir, quedó claro que era lo que necesitábamos y es Dios quien nos pide rendirnos a Su majestad y comenzar a buscar seria y activamente la santidad. Ciertamente, este fue un hermoso llamado de atención de nuestro Señor para mí como Su sacerdote. Sabemos que necesitamos ser santos y buscar al Señor con todo nuestro corazón, pero si somos honestos, ¿cuánto tiempo dedicamos realmente a diario hacia este objetivo, ya que la mayoría de nosotros estamos enterrados con responsabilidades, proyectos, familia, trabajo y muchas otras ansiedades que llenan nuestros corazones?

Este domingo se nos recuerda sobre el fin de los tiempos; el fin del mundo como lo conocemos y la venida final de Jesucristo. El Evangelio nos recuerda sobre la gran tribulación (Mc 13:24-32), ciertamente imágenes que pueden llevar al miedo. En medio de esa oscuridad se nos habla de la gloria, el gran poder y los ángeles que acompañan la majestad de Jesucristo. En la oscuridad brillará la gloria de Dios. El poder de Jesucristo atravesará la oscuridad más profunda. Aquí es donde entra en juego la importancia de la oración contemplativa y el diálogo íntimo con Jesús. Esta gloria y poder de Dios atravesando la oscuridad no sólo sucederá al fin del mundo. Cuando oramos, mientras pasamos tiempo con Nuestro Señor en silencio – acompañándolo en soledad – el poder de Dios atraviesa las luchas, sufrimientos y desafíos de nuestras vidas. La gloria de Dios se encuentra con nuestra necesidad mientras buscamos activamente la gloria de Jesucristo. Cuanto más buscamos, oramos y nos apartamos de nuestras vidas ocupadas para estar con Jesucristo, más llegamos a conocer y experimentar la gloria, el poder y la majestad de Dios. Mientras lo contemplamos y lo buscamos en oración, entraremos en contacto con el mismo Jesús que viene al final del mundo. Realmente podemos conocer, experimentar y amar a nuestro Salvador mientras nos dejamos conocer por Él en la oración – mientras nos volvemos vulnerables y compartimos nuestra vida con Él. Entonces experimentamos Su presencia, Su rostro y corazón, amándonos, sosteniéndonos, sanándonos y abrazándonos en nuestra propia oscuridad. No teman al fin del mundo; teman más perder la oportunidad de experimentar Su presencia, gloria y amor cada día por no venir a Él en silencio. No hay santidad sin oración. No hay cielo sin venir a Jesucristo en oración mental silenciosa.




